Glendale Nine Begins Season Minus Drills

MOUNTAINDALE—The Glendale Area High baseball team, which lacks proper facilities to hold indoor workouts, goes into tomorrow's opener against West Branch with just one practice to its credit, and Coach Matt Bordack doesn't know where to start naming his lineup.

Bordack coached at Reade Township here for a dozen seasons before the merger with B-C-I last year and, since the latter didn't field a diamond team the past few seasons, will count heavily on Reade Center boys.

"I have no other choice," he said. "We got outside one day about three weeks ago and it was too windy to do anything. Everybody else has been getting a little rain but we've been getting snow."

Seven players who held down regular positions for Reade Township last year will be the mainstays this year.

They are junior Greg Sahn and Terry Andrew, a pair of big, hard-throwing pitchers, senior second baseman Greg Scott, junior shortstop Tom Evansky, and senior outfielders Barry McClellan, Cecil McClellan and Bob Dick. Barry McClellan is a three-year veteran.

Also available for work on the mound are seniors Bill Fleming and Norm Dillon, the only left-hander, and sophomore Jim Yingling.

Fleming will be at first base when he isn't pitching and is backed by senior Fran Gondek.

Lanny Frisco, a senior, and Barry Kutruff, a junior, will alternate behind the plate, while junior third baseman Gary Frisco rounds out the starting unit.

Other infield candidates are seniors Tony Pino and Roger Peacock, sophomore Tim Tiesi and freshman Pat Pino.

Bob Tokarchick, a junior, and Mike Dobish, a senior, join Dillon and Peacock as possible outfield hopefuls.

The Vikings play only an eight-game schedule, all in the Moshannon Valley League.

They take on Curwensville, Clearfield, West Branch and Moshannon Valley.

All games begin at 4 p. m., with home games carded for the Reade Center diamond at Mountaindale.
