**FLINTON —** A two run triple in the bottom of the eighth inning by Nina Gabrielson scored the winning runs as Glendale remained unbeaten by downing stubborn West Branch 8-7 in a Moshannon Valley Softball League tilt yesterday.

Gabrielson's three-bagger brought Glendale from the edge of defeat to their sixth league victory without a loss. With the score tied 6-6 after seven innings, West Branch tallied in the top of the seventh to take a 7-6 lead.

However, Robn Laing led off the bottom of the eighth with a single and Sue Matthews walked. Laing attempted to steal (which she did) and tried to come home on an overthrow but was pegged out at the plate as Matthews moved into second.

Brenda Ball rapped a single off losing pitcher Tam Viehdorfer to put runners at first and third before Gabrielson rocketed her game-winning triple.

That was Gabrielson's only hit of the day for the Vikettes

of Coach Julianna Ondecko, but a quartet of Glendale swingers rapped two or more hits. Brenda Ball ripped four safettes, including a triple, Laing and Mary Ann Zendeck had three hits apiece and Deb Matthews cracked two hits.

Shelva Strible stroked a quartet of hits and Paula Casher and Marlene Andrews each poked two hits for West Branch.
