Glendale Clinches Title On Wagner No-Hitter

Glendale tops Westmont for first ever District 6 title

ALTOONA—All the eyes of Glendale will be smiling on the Lady Viking softball squad as they captured the first district title in school history by downing top-seeded Westmont-Hilltop 2-1 in the District 6-AA final Friday afternoon.

Viking Coach Pat Pino was thrilled with his team's accomplishment. "This is the first district title for Glendale in any sport," exclaimed Pino. "We had teams make it to the finals, but we were the first team to come through with a title."

Glendale will now take on District 9 champion Brockway Tuesday afternoon at the Morrisdale Little League Field. The undefeated Lady Vikings will take an 18-game winning streak

into the game.

Friday's championship tilt was tight all the way, as one would expect between to teams of such high caliber. Glendale cracked under the pressure early in the game, allowing the Lady Hilltoppers to sneak a run through in the second.

Rose Tomak led off the second frame by smashing a double for Westmont. Tomak darted toward third for the steal, but was able to run all the way home due to an errant throw by Viking catcher Nicole Smith.
