### Wagner no-hits Chestnut Ridge

BEDFORD — In the opening round of the interdistrict playoffs, District 5 champion Chestnut Ridge's uniforms were so similar to District 6 champion Glendale that it was hard to tell the two teams apart — until Jen Wagner took the mound.

Wagner struck out 11, walked two and allowed only four balls hit out of the infield as she tossed her second no-hitter of the season. She was backed by a strong Lady Vikings defense which committed no errors. Offensively, Glendale racked up nine hits in the 6-0 victory over the Lady Lions.

"When you get to the inter-districts and throw a no-hitter, it's sort of overwhelming," said Glendale coach Pat Pino. "It was an outstanding performance."

Glendale upped its record to 19-3 and will move on to the second round to play Riverside, which defeated Fort LeBoeuf 9-1 yesterday. Chestnut Ridge ends its season with a 17-3 record.

Wagner set the tone early in this one, striking out the side in the first inning. Those three players went down swinging. Eight others would follow as the game progressed.

"I felt really good out there. I was just moving it around, throwing some drops and changing the speeds on them," a smiling Wagner said following her 13th career no-hitter.

In the bottom of the first, she got all the offense she would need, and the Lady Vikings did not have to hit the ball out of the infield.

With one out, Sherri Frisco walked and stole second. Wagner then beat out an infield single and stole second as well. After Nichole Smith struck out, Nicki Turner hit a routine grounder to short, and it appeared as if the Lady Lions had avoided a rough inning.

That was not the case.

Chestnut Ridge's shortstop Kristin Hoover picked up the ball cleanly but threw it away for a

two-base error. Frisco and Wagner scored, and the Lady Vikings lead was 2-0.

Wagner almost lost the no-hitter and the shutout in the second inning. She walked the leadoff batter, Leslie Miller, who stole second. A ground out moved her to third. Sherri Frisco saved a hit and consequential run when she snared a line drive off the bat of Hoover.

Miller was the only base runner the Lady Lions had through the first six innings.

Glendale added to its lead in the fourth. Roxanne Jasper bunted for a single and went all the way to third when third baseman Robin Stern threw the ball down the first base line. She scored on a Julie Wagner ground out.

Meanwhile, Wagner continued to dominate Chestnut Ridge. She had excellent control, and continually kept the batters guessing. After the line drive to Frisco in the second, the Lady Lions did not have anything resembling a hit the rest of the way. In the third, fourth, fifth and sixth inn-

ings, Wagner sent them down in order, retiring 15 in a row during the stretch.

"Honestly, I didn't know what to expect from Wagner," said Chestnut Ridge coach Jim Miller. "She changed speeds real well and basically had us off balance the whole game."

Glendale was anything but off balance at the plate. In the fifth, the Lady Vikings scored three times to take a commanding 6-0 lead. Koteas led off with a bunt single, and Frisco sacrificed, moving her up. Jen Wagner walked, and after a fly out, Nicki Turner's infield single brought home the fourth Glendale run.

With two on, Connie Jasper doubled to left field, clearing the bases and adding the final two Lady Vikings runs. Pino was pleased with the offensive output.

"The bottom of the order came through again. We hit the ball and played good defense. Everything that we had to do, we did," he said.

Chestnut Ridge got its second base runner in the seventh. Lee Ann Mock walked, stole second and went to third on a fly out. However, Dee Barefoot's grounder to Connie Jasper closed out the win and the no-hitter.

"We're probably playing as well as we can play and that's good," Pino said. "This is where you want to do it."
