# Glendale softball seeks improvement

FLINTÓN — Glendale softball coach Jay Arnold isn't one

to mix words.

The Lady Vikings enter their second season under Arnold's watch, and his goal for the team is as simple as they come — to

get better.

Glendale went 2-16 in Arnold's first season with both wins coming at the expense of winless Harmony. To improve on last year's mark, the Lady Vikings will need to cut down on their mistakes and infuse an offense that scored just 3.6 runs per contest.

While the defense committed 64 errors last year, Glendale pitchers still had an ERA over

13.00.

Ideally, Arnold and Co. would like to see just what they have this season, but Mother Nature has been anything but cooperative.

"We know who can throw and hit," said Arnold "It's difficult to judge defense on a wooden or concrete surface. We are working to get better game to game.

"We need to work on footwork and proper throwing. We need to bat stronger than we did last year. We need to get better."

Arnold will rely on his four etterwinners to help usher in some new and inexperienced players to the varsity level.

Senior Katelyn Matthews leads the list of returnees, as she was the Lady Vikings' top pitcher and hitter a season ago

In the circle, Matthews logged 46 2/3 innings, where she allowed 106 hits, struck out 37 and walked 56.

Matthews compiled a 286 average and led the team with

10 stolen bases.

After splitting time in the circle a season ago, Matthews will be Arnold's No. 1 pitcher with junior Stephanie Hamilton and sophomore Morgan Strong also vying for time.

Hamilton will see action at shortstop as well, while Matthews has seen a bulk of her playing time outside the circle

at second base.

Senior lettermen Nina Heverly and Kyresten Whetstone will return to their positions at third and first base, respectively, while classmate Elisha Matier will play second base.

Sophomore Mandee Glass is also in the mix at short and third, while junior letterwinner Heather McCully will be the

team's catcher.

Arnold says the three spots in the outfield are still up for grabs.
