# May 30, 2017: Claysburg 4 vs Glendale 5 District 6 Playoffs

STATE COLLEGE — With the ball spinning on the ground between Glendale's Makenzie Lukehart and Claysburg-Kimmel's Raelynne Grabill after a violent collision at first base, Lady Viking Lexi Mulhollen never stopped running.

Mulhollen, who reached on a walk to lead off the bottom of the seventh inning, took off for second on Lukehart's bunt. When Grabill dropped the ball after the collison, Mulhollen decided to take matters into her own hands, rounding third base and sprinting for home with the game hanging in the balance.

She slid home just ahead of the tag and a jubilant celebration ensued at home plate Wednesday at Nittany Lion Softball Park as the Lady Vikings claimed a 5-4 victory and their first District 6 title since 1992.

"I wasn't even looking at (third base and head coach Phil Barroner)," Mulhollen said. "I decided to take a chance. We needed a run and I went for it."

"I thought, 'let's take a chance," Barroner said. "You only get so many opportunities."

The wild ending spoiled a valiant comeback for the Lady Bulldogs, who rallied from a 4-1 deficit to tie it with three runs in the sixth, only to see it slip away on the strange turn of

events.

Mulhollen reached base after drawing a walk off Lady Bulldog pitcher Courtney Garver, the only free pass she issued in the game.

Lukehart put down a perfect sac bunt, dropping the ball a foot in front of home plate where it just stopped. Catcher Samantha Fickes fired to first when Grabill was covering the bag.

Grabill caught the ball just as Lukehart reached the bag and the two collided as the Lady Bulldog second baseman's momentum took her into the Glendale runner. The umpire called out, but then changed his call a second later when he saw the ball lying on the ground.

Mulhollen was just past second when the collision occurred and decided to keep going as the Lady Bulldogs seemed bewildered by the turn of events.

"It's part of the game," Claysburg-Kimmel head coach Mike Barbarini said. "It seemed like it was their destiny to win on that play. All of our girls just kind of stopped when they collided. It's something you can't teach your girls in practice."

Glendale jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first off Garver, who beat the Lady Vikings twice during the regular season.

Makenize Lukehart and Kristen Hewitt hit back-to-back, one-out singles to get the Lady Vkings going.

After Garver struck out Alaney Vereshack for the second out, she got in front of Sydney Gallaher 0-1 on a high swinging strike.

But Gallaher recovered and drilled the next pitch to the gap in right-center for a 2-run double.

"You want to yell at her after swinging at a pitch above her head and then she looks so fluid on the next pitch and hits one to the gap," Barroner said. "It was great to see her have a shining moment here as a senior."

Gallaher had two hits, while Glendale collected 10 in the game. Hewitt and Ellie Leyo also had a pair of hits.

"We tried a new approach (against Garver)," Barroner said. "She is very aggressive in the strike zone early in the count, so we went after pitches a little earlier."

"We came in here looking to put the ball in play," Gallaher said. "We respect them a lot, but we really wanted it. It was a messy ending, but we'll take it."

Mulhollen added to the Glendale lead in the bottom of the second, pouncing on the first pitch from Garver and sending it over the left field fence to up the advantage to 3-0.

The Lady Bulldogs got their first hit off Mulhollen in the third, a one-out double for Keyara Morgan that followed a Fickes walk.

With runners on second and third, Mulhollen was called for an illegal pitch, allowing Fickes to score.

Mulhollen was called for the illegal pitch four times in the game, which rattled her as time went on.

Glendale scored a key run in the bottom of the fifth, putting together a pair of hits after two outs.

Hewitt singled before her courtesy runner Lauryn Clarkson stole second. Vereshack followed with a base hit to right, knocking in Clarkson to make the score 4-1.

The run proved key as the Lady Bulldogs rallied for three in the sixth.

Morgan, Mikalynn Bauman and Garver hit consecutive singles to start the inning. Morgan scored on Garver's hit.

Madison Knisley plated Bauman with an RBI groundout and Emily Claar knocked in Claar with Claysburg's fourth hit of the inning.

Mulhollen got the next two batters to fly out and pop out to get out of the inning before running into more trouble in the seventh.

With two out, Mulhollen got Morgan to fly out to center for what appeared to be the final out.

But she was called for an illegal pitch and the out was wiped out

Three pitches later, Morgan singled for her third hit of the game. Bauman followed with a base hit of her own, but Mulhollen got Garver to ground out to third baseman Kennedy LeMaster to end the threat and set up the wild final at bat.

"I think Lexi got in her own head a little bit," Barroner said. "But she kept us in the game. She let her defense do the work. Our defense has been pretty solid this year."

"The illegal pitches psyched me out," Mulhollen said. "I was down on myself a little bit."

But not for long as the Lady Viking sophomore will only remember scoring the winning run and winning a District title when she thinks about this game later in life.

"We worked so hard for this all year," she said. "I am so happy."

The district title is the culmination of a four-year plan for Barroner, whose goal was to have this group, led by seniors Gallaher, Leyo, Keneisha Gustafson, Clarkson and Kyla Holtz, compete for a championship as seniors.

"When I started this four years ago I had a good group of freshmen that just believed in the system and went to work," Barroner said. "Four years later, it paid off."

"I'm so excited," Gallaher said. "We thought we would win it last year, but to do it this year as a senior ... it's just awesome."

The Lady Vikings are back in action Monday in the first round of the PIAA playoffs. They play the runner-up (Muncy or Northeast Bradford) from District 4 at a site and time to be determined.
