Sports Booster President, Amy Emmatty: There is a golf tournament meeting tonight.
Recording Secretary's Report, Susan Anderson: January minutes are delayed; they will be emailed to the Board along with the February minutes and posted next month. The sign up sheet is going around.

Athletic Director, Jonathan Frohm: There is a lot going on. If you get or have questions, please just keep us posted. We are trying to communicate better via Twitter and Website regarding Concussion documents. Our Golf coach is leaving, Mark is a 1997 HHS grad and has coached a variety of sports for 20 years. We are also in need of a Cheerleading coach.
Finishing up winter sports and going into the championships. Spring sports start February 18, there is no school but there are tryouts that day. Locations for tryouts are being announced as able. There will be a meeting February 11 with the coaches to share everything we want them to know. Meet the Coach is March 4 at 6:30. Spring awards will be June 5 and 6 .
The new softball scoreboard has been ordered and will have blank ad space available. We can add this to our advertising form.

Concessions Report, Kelli Jordan: All is going well, everything is stocked, and Nancy is a rockstar with volunteers. We are considering adding baked chips for the after-school concession stand.

Apparel, Kim Douglas \& Jen Schoenfeldt: Everything is going well. We donated three baskets with sales items and underselling items, baskets are valued at approximately $\$ 100$. Two were donated to All Night Grad and one to St Joe's for the Spring Fling auction. Will review and work on online store this summer and figure out the logistics of deliveries.

Sponsorship and Advertising, Monica Snowden \& Iris Britt: Applied for donation from Modell's but no response yet. Going forward will always include a date the donation is needed that is a few weeks out. We are contacting WalMart, applications opened February 1, as well as the Wizards and MARS candy company foundation. Approaching MARS to sponsor the new scorer's table.

Membership, Stephanie Naski: There were no new memberships in January. As in year's past, we plan to discount memberships by $50 \%$ as of March 1 . Last year we sold 12 discounted memberships, $\$ 1150$. While we anticipate selling more memberships, we only have 65 tags left! If we get into a situation where we have more orders than tags, we will distribute paper passes rather than order more passes at this point in the year.

Communications Secretary Report, Susan Anderson: Will add the open coach positions to the weekly newsletter.

Nothing new for social media. If there is something to be posted, contact Stephanie.

Treasurer, Danielle LaRosa: We continue to do very well. Highlights:

Concessions brought in almost $\$ 5,000$ in January revenue. $\$ 3,800$ was from evening sports and the rest was after school.

Donations continue to be strong - we received an unsolicited $\$ 1,000$ donation plus another $\$ 2,000$ from the wish list.

With the wish list and concessions, our old adage of $90 \%$ of all revenue is earned in the Fall is no longer valid. We now have earned $25 \%$ of our revenue and profit during the winter season.

Propose a donation of $\$ 10,000$ at the Winter Sports awards. The proposal was approved.

Note: programs were created by the UPS Store and Amy; would like to consider adding other groups in the fall program and need to revisit who will sell them.

Old Business: Golf Tournament update. After the success of the wish list and how specific we were about where the donations would be spent, it sparked a discussion at the last meeting if we should have each hole represent a sport/team or something that specifically supports the teams and present it that way to potential sponsors.

New Business: There was no new business discussed.
Meeting adjourned at 6:30pm; next Meeting will be held on March 4, 2019.
