CURRENT YEAR FINANCIALS

- o Checking, Savings and PayPal accounts have been reconciled as of August 31, 2018
- As of 8/31/18, there is over \$55,000 between Checking account, PayPal, Savings Account & Bank Bags
- Although the P&L for August shows a loss of <\$459.21>, the Actual Cash Flow for August 2018 was \$4,390.79
- **PREVIOUS YEAR** Comparison Financial Statements:
 - Profit for this school year was <694.15> compared to 8/31/17 of <\$4,560> this is due to not purchasing any spirit wear items yet.
 - Concessions Income is down 60%--due to only 1 home game so far.
 - Concessions Expense is down 27%
 - Stadium Signs Income increased 10%
 - Membership Income increased 97%
 - Spirit Wear Income is down 54%
 - Spirit Wear Expense is also down 41%
 - Total expense are down 41%
 - Cash on Hand is up 33%
