

During the fall football season of 1938, Rebel fans of all ages walked through the "gates of history" when they attended the official dedication of the Godfrey-Lee Field. Removed some sixty years later to widen the entrance to the field, a project was begun to restore this landmark as part of the new "*Rebel Pride Pavilion*." The first phase of that project was completed with the dedication of the rebuilt gate on September 22, 2006. Phase II has begun! We want to extend the walkways, emplace decorative fencing, and create a pavilion that will be the pride of every Rebel alumnus.


