Recognized accomplishments will include team accomplishments, team records held, and impact on the overall athletic program at Malden Catholic.
- All inductees shall have demonstrated the highest level of standards of conduct during competition, as a student on campus, and as a citizen in the community including character, leadership and sportsmanship.
