Housing and Meals

A fully trained and dependable staff will monitor all residence halls for the duration of camp. All camp meals will be eaten in South Dining Hall, located within walking distance from the residence hall and Keystone Hall. Resident campers will receive breakfast, lunch and dinner daily. Commuting campers will receive lunch and dinner only. The first meal served will be dinner on Monday, and the last meal served will be lunch on Thursday.

The camps will be under the direction of former Lock Haven University Head Wrestling Coach Carl Poff. Poff was instrumental in helping LHU become one of the premier wrestling programs in the nation. Co-Director: Rob Fisher

Over the past ten years, Coach Rob Fisher has amassed a dual meet record of 118-62-2 as the head coach at Kutztown University. Fisher has coached a two time NCAA champion and his wrestlers have earned seven All-American honors. Fisher guided the Golden Bears to their best season in program history in 2009-10 and set the school record for single season wins with seventeen. Fisher also recorded his 100th career coaching win that same season. Under his guidance KU has become one of the premier Division II programs in the country.
