MSSFHA and Cape Cod Summer Field Hockey League Waiver, Assumption of Risk and Informed Consent must be signed by Participant (and Parent/Guardian if under 18) in order to play – **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!** In consideration for acceptance as a participant in the MSSFHA Cape Cod Summer Field Hockey League, the undersigned player (and Parent/Guardian of player under 18 years of age) releases MSSFHA, its officers, directors, agents and assigns, as well as all summer league staff, other players, and volunteers including officials, site directors and league directors, as well as the Town of Yarmouth, including their public schools, recreation departments and community programs, from any and all claims for any loss, damage and/or injury sustained by the participant. The participant (and his/her Parent/Guardian if under 18 years of age) is aware of and hereby knowingly assumes all risks associated with or arising from participating in the sport of field hockey and this league. The undersigned further confirms that the participant is covered by medical insurance and that said insurance is accurately listed on this application and is in full force and effect for the duration of the summer league season. Your signature below also authorizes the site directors and the coach or parent representative of the participant's summer league team to secure emergency medical treatment for the participant should it become necessary. **NOTE: NO ATHLETIC TRAINERS OR MEDICS ARE ON SITE.**

The participant (and Parent/Guardian of a player under 18 years of age) agrees and acknowledges that field hockey is a game played by two teams on a rectangular field and that each player carries a curved stick for the purpose of propelling a hard ball up and down the field and into the goal cage. The goal is 12 feet wide and 7 feet high (when cones are used, the height is judged by officials). The ball is a hard, solid sphere made of plastic. Team players dress in uniform shirts and all field players are required to wear mouth protectors and shin guards; eye goggles are required for all high school players and recommended for all other players. NO JEWELRY ALLOWED. The goalkeeper is required to wear a full face mask, chest and throat protector, helmet, leg pads, kickers and gloves, and any other desired protective gear.

This league has players of all ages and all skill levels from beginner to advanced. High school rules will be followed except as modified by MSSFHA for summer league play. This League will use officials who hold current ratings and are members in good standing on their local umpiring board. Officials' decisions on game play are final. All participants in the League are expected to have at least basic knowledge of the rules of the game of field hockey, as well as the basic skills needed to compete. Due to the nature of the game of field hockey, there is occasional contact between the ball or stick and a part of the body, as well as occasional unintentional contact between players. As with any athletic endeavor there is always the risk of personal injury.

I have read the above and understand the nature of the game and the risks involved in participating in the summer league. I knowingly accept and assume these risks, waive any claims arising therefrom as outlined above, and hereby confirm that I would like to participate in the Cape Cod Summer Field Hockey League.
