Spectator Parking is very limited. Parking for all stadium events is located on the northwest side of the stadium off of Harris Avenue as well as in the Lindner Family Waterworks Park. Additional parking is available on Harris Avenue as well. There is no parking in reserved parking spaces or fire lane(s).

Ticketing

Tickets to Norwood City School Events will be sold electronically via Hometown Ticketing. Tickets will be available for an hour after the contest has started. Doors for events will open 45 minutes from the scheduled start. Ex: 6:15 PM for 7:00 PM Varsity Football game.

Concessions:

Concessions will be available at most home events, courtesy of the Norwood Boosters. Unless otherwise noted.

Sports Medicine:

Norwood City Schools Athletic Trainer Greg O'Donnell will be present at all varsity level events. Dr. Richard A. Okragly Jr. MD, will be present for home and away football contest. Coolers and Ice will be provided by the Norwood Athletic Department. Schools are responsible for providing their own water bottles/cups. Please inform the Norwood City Schools Athletics Office if your school's Athletic Trainer will not be present.

Under no circumstance can our athletic trainer apply tape and pre-wrap to opposing schools student-athletes. Also, our trainer will not provide athletic tape and pre-wrap. We ask if tape and pre-wrap is needed to have it done before arrival.

Locker Rooms:

Locker Rooms for visiting schools will be available in the Middle School Fieldhouse, High School Gym and Shea Stadium.

Security:

Security Detail is provided by the Norwood Police Department for Varsity Football and Basketball Games.

Re-Entry:

Re-Entry is not permitted at any Norwood City Schools Athletics Event.

Alcohol and Smoking:

Norwood City School District is a tobacco and alcohol free district. No alcoholic beverages, smoking, vaping or chewing tobacco is permitted at any of our facilities.

Press Box and Filming:

The press box at Shea Stadium will be available for Football games and Soccer Matches. Games can be filmed from the visiting team's press box or the top of the Shea Stadium press box.
