1) FORMS:

ALL forms provided in this packet need to be completed and <u>turned in to Coach</u>

<u>Davenport the first day of practice (Monday, February 26.)</u> Please write legibly on each form. *Note: Players <u>will not</u> be eligible to practice until forms are turned it – no exceptions!*

- Drivers Form (Form FS-142)
 - All drivers (parent, coach and student) must fill out this form and give it to your coach if you are going to drive to or from games, team functions, etc. this year

- Picture form: <u>Do not</u> turn in with the forms to coaches. Players are responsible for bringing the picture form and the check to picture day

- 3) **Spirit Wear** All spirit wear will be ordered online via BSN Sports for GSOC Spirit Wear. Flyer and directions for ordering spirit wear is attached.
 - Go online and place the order using the link provided in flyer. All orders are placed via credit card paid directly to BSN Sports.
 - ALL ORDERS MUST BE PLACED by midnight MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26th. The site closes at midnight on 2/26, orders will not re-open. It is anticipated it will take ~3 ½ weeks to fulfill the orders. The items will be distributed to the players during practice.
 - Parents are welcome to order spirit wear for themselves as well!
 - Players/Parents do not need to provide jersey numbers. Once numbers are assigned by the Coach it will be provided to BSN.

4) General Information:

- Bus Transportation for away games:
 - ONE (1) bus for JV that departs Oakton, door # 6
 - ONE (1) bus for Varsity that departs Oakton, Door # 6
 - Always check before each game for notice outside activities office in the event of any last-minute changes.
 - There <u>will not</u> be buses to bring the athletes back to Oakton after away games. All athletes will need to ride home with their parent or another student.
 - All the above driving forms must be completed by every player/adult.
- <u>Subway order</u>: Varsity players will be getting subway sandwiches for all away games.
 It will include the sub, water and chips. The order form is included in the packet for
 the girls. <u>Submit Subway order form and \$30.00 check/cash</u>. <u>Make checks payable</u>
 to Maria Fisher.

- <u>Team Dinners</u>: Varsity team dinners will be set up throughout the season. Some team dinners will be hosted at player's homes and some will be in local restaurants selected by players. TBD will coordinate team dinners throughout the season.
- <u>Fundraiser</u>: We will be having our annual Krispy Kreme fundraiser and other fundraisers as identified. Pre-sales start now with the receipt of the packet. - Athlete Buttons: Supplies for making buttons and the button maker are available through CougarAthletic boosters. The team button rep will coordinate the picture taking, duplication of picture, and will help make and sell buttons. Buttons will be sold 2 for \$10.00. This is coordinated with JV.
 - Varsity Parent:
- Team Dinners: Coordination of Varsity team dinners either hosted by parents or held at local restaurants or school typically held 1 per week throughout the season
 - Varsity Coordinator:
- ► <u>Home Game Programs</u>: We need a volunteer to prepare programs for each home game and a special program for Senior Night.
 - Varsity Parent:
- Concession Stand: Every family is required to sign up tonight for concession stand duty. We need a Varsity Parent to be the overall coordinator to help with the money and closing the stand. Sign up for ALL parents will be via Sign Up Genius, so is somewhat simplified.
 - Varsity parents open the stand at 5:00pm and volunteer during the JV games. JV
 parents report to concessions immediately following the conclusion of their game
 and volunteer during the Varsity game, to include closing. Proceeds benefit the
 Athletic Boosters.
 - JV parents close the stand after the Varsity Game.

> <u>Ticket Takers:</u>

➤ 1-2 JV parents will be responsible for taking gate tickets for the Varsity game and 1-2 Varsity Parents will be responsible for taking gate tickets for the JV game. Sign up will be via Sign up Genius.

- ➤ <u>Clock and Announcer</u>: Varsity parents will be responsible for announcing the home games and running the clock for the home games. They will need to be at all home games at least 15 minutes before game start.

- **Subway Pick Up for away games**: Varsity athletes will be riding the bus with the JV team to all away games.
