#### **General Membership Open Time**

- Prom Fundraising
  - Michelle Crain is the mother of the Jr. class president. She is soliciting ideas of fundraisers for the junior class to raise funds for Prom. Target amount to raise is \$6,000.
     50/50 raffle was discussed. Adults need to sell the 50/50 raffle as it is viewed as a form of gambling. She does not need to seek permission from the booster club.
  - **Action**: Valerie Calloway will follow up with her though on ideas and possible sponsorships.
- Class of 2019 display on football field fence
  - Felicia Huweart and her husband graciously donated the permanent display of the Class of 2019 plastic tags at the football field fence. She disclosed it was approximate \$200 donation. She provided information to the boosters as to how the school can continue with this display from year to year.
  - **Action**: Boosters board will look at expanding this display.

- Softball Dugouts
  - Coach Tom Spavone discussed the need of the softball dugouts to be painted. He has
    personally spent around \$300 to paint the one dugout. Estimates it will take an additional
    \$200 to finish the painting. He has not submitted any formal request. Treasurer Jeremy
    Reeve stated he can submit the formal request, and to include past costs in the request as
    well.
  - Action: Coach Spavone needs to submit formal request for funds to paint the softball dugouts.

# **Officer's Reports**

- Treasurer's Report (Jeremy Reeve) dated 9/30/2018 Total assets were \$171,710.41. Current Activities Budget is \$110,550.39. Operating general fund balance is \$61,160.02. Net fundraising profit is \$63,287.26.
  - \*\*Patriot card sales money has not yet been distributed to the team/club accounts.

      - Will a winter fundraiser be done for the winter teams/clubs? The boosters are exploring a winter Polar Fun Run
    - Action: President Jon Carroll will speak with Theresa to see if actual Patriot cards are still available to sell.
    - Action: President Jon Carroll will find out when the spring mulch sales begins.
    - Action: Boosters continue exploring the feasibility of a winter Polar Fun Run in January.
- Secretary's Report (Tina Blackman) September meeting minutes have been posted online. Emails/Twitter/FB posts have been sent out regarding the pick up dates and times for the free booster gear with membership purchase. Again encouraged team/club sponsors to send to the secretary for posting to the media outlets any spirit nights, fundraisers, announcements.
- Member at Large Report (Tina Blackman on behalf of Theresa Brown)
  - Motion approved for Hudle Sideline at half the requested amount. Approved unanimously. Request was for \$1500.00. It was approved at \$750.00
  - Motion unanimously approved for the purchase of a Boosters table throw to be used at events. The amount was approved up to \$300.00

All coaches/sponsors have been contacted regarding where they stand with regard to their teams earning or outstanding funds/cards. I will have a full report out of online sales and the total amount earned from the fundraiser at the November meeting.
