

Top 10 Things to Know About Concessions

- 10. We are in desperate need of parents willing to train and work as concession managers.
- 9. We don't work without your volunteers. Do whatever it takes to motivate them.
- 8. Parents, high school students and older siblings may volunteer, but children younger than high school age will not be allowed in the concession stand.
- 7. We will try to schedule your volunteers only during your season, however, we may need them to volunteer at other times. Please give them a heads-up.
- 6. Team parents will save you time and energy. Have them assign volunteers and communicate with concession managers. Make sure we have their contact information.
- 5. The volunteer shifts will start 1 hour before the event begins and end once clean up is complete. If 2 events are on the same night the first shift may leave once they have trained another volunteer.
- 4. We will need a list of volunteer names prior to events to give to the staff selling admission tickets.
- 3. Each team may choose to have 5 free meal deals to distribute as the coach wishes. Tickets for the free meals must be picked up from the concession stand prior to the start of the event and must be redeemed before the stand closes.
