

SOFTBALL 2019

I hope you all are excited for the softball season! I have put together a small packet to give you as much information as possible to start planning for our season. The schedule provided is an indoor/outdoor schedule. Please keep in mind this schedule is subject to change. I will give as much advanced warning as possible but last minute changes are inevitable.

All players will be evaluated at Try-outs Monday March 11th-Wednesday March 13th. Beginning Wednesday March 13th running through the rest of the week individual meetings will occur during practice to notify players of their status with the program. At this time possible positions and playing time, strength and weakness will also be discussed. This does not mean their positions or playing time is set in stone, but we will be honest with players knowing this is a big commitment. They should discuss their evaluations with their parents. Also note that playing time or position is NOT guaranteed, negotiable, or equal.

If we are able to go outside, we will! The girls should come to school prepared everyday for either inside or outside practice. If we are outside, practice will run roughly 3:30/3:45-6:00. Please know with our displacement this is subject to change. We are going to see if a 3:30 start is a feasible time once we are able to get outside. If 3:30 is too difficult for the players we will move it to 3:45. Being on time is mandatory. Please keep in mind the players are required to take care of their equipment and field prior to leaving, and then they will be dismissed from practice. The times that are listed each day on the calendar are gym times. We will go outside as much and as soon as possible. If weather is in question there will be a message sent to let players know of indoor vs outdoor practice.

We do take great pride in this softball program and intend to continue with its great tradition. We want players with integrity that have pride in representing our school and community. There will be a focus on fundamentals daily. Every player should be learning, improving and growing every day. We demand hard work and commitment. We are looking for players to represent the program on the field, in the classroom and in the community. A player's attitude, hustle, level of commitment, athletic ability, versatility, eligibility status and classroom behavior are major factors in our program. Experience and talent are beneficial to have but keep in mind hard work and attitude are characteristics we want representing our program.

DURING TRY-OUTS YOU WILL BE EVALUATED ON THE FOLLOWING:

SPEED-

Base running

Single, double, triple, homerun, steal off the pitch, from dive back position and defensively

DEFENSIVE-

Footwork

Infield and outfield: side to side movement, drop step, over the shoulder, at the base/plate

Glove work

Forehand, back hand, one hop, ground balls and fly balls at different depths

THROWING-

Technique, accuracy, strength .

HITTING-

Form and technique

Bunting and slapping

Form, technique and control

PTICHERS-

Fastball speed and accuracy, other pitches

CATCHING-

Blocking, picking, fly balls, framing, throwing accuracy and form

MOST IMPORTANTLY

Attitude, hustle, communication and coachability

We will meet with all players to discuss strengths and weaknesses along with the role we believe they will play or need them to play on the team and in the program. This is not to discourage but to simply inform players of what is expected out of them so there are no surprises. (For example: playing time and position) Please discuss this evaluation as a family so everyone is informed of the expectations that the coaching staff has for the player. The role on a team is every changing and we will continue to discuss these as the season progresses with individual players as needed.
