

ATHLETIC REGISTRATION FOR SALINE AREA SCHOOLS

2022 - 2023

General Facts (sports offered, tryout/season start dates, and head coach email addresses) about SAS Athletics can be found here: [Saline High School](#) and [Saline Middle School](#) . If you don't see your sport listed, please see note below:

* Note: all 6th grade sports and some other MS & HS sports are run through Community Ed, not Saline Athletics. Registration for those programs, and more information can be found [HERE](#).

Step 1: COMPLETE ATHLETIC REGISTRATION FORMS ONLINE – BIG TEAMS ACCOUNT

Registration and an updated physical exam must be submitted before the first day of practice/tryouts and only needs to be filled out one time per year. BIG TEAMS is a brand new system to Saline so parents/guardians AND student(s) must each make a new account **As this is the first year, students registered in PowerSchool by July 22, 2022 automatically had a Big Teams account made for them using their school email address and temporary password as bigteams (all lowercase)**. Students should have an email from "Student Central" inviting them to complete their account information. If they did not receive this please sign in using your saline school email. These accounts will be active as long as a student is in Saline Area Schools (MS students will use their same account as they enter HS sports). You can find the registration website [HERE](#) . Guardians/Parents, click "Sign Up" for a Big Teams account, and fill out information accordingly.

* Note: In regards to students under the age of 13, with Big Teams COPPA compliance, students under the age of 13 do NOT have to fill out digital forms. Their guardians/parents can do the work for them. When the guardian/parent creates their account, they click "Link Accounts", and then can click "My Child is under the age of 13." This will allow them to input their students information, and then proceed to filling out the forms.

Step 2: MEDICAL HISTORY

Each student must electronically submit a physical **dated after April 15, 2022** to the Saline Athletic Office through Big Teams as mentioned above. Completed physicals may be submitted into your Big Teams [account](#) by scanning or taking a picture with a smartphone of ALL pages of the exam. If you are having trouble uploading a physical exam form, please email Tiffani Harris (harrist2@salineschools.org). The physical exam must be received **BEFORE** a student's first practice/tryout. No exceptions. This is a safety policy as well as a MHSAA mandate.

* PLEASE DO **NOT** GIVE A PAPER COPY OF THE PHYSICAL TO THE MAIN OFFICE, ATHLETIC OFFICE, OR A COACH - upload it to your account

* Note: Options for getting a Sports Physical:

1. See your own pediatrician for a full exam after **Apr 15, 2022** but before their respective season start date
2. [Trinity Health](#), Urgent Care, Concentra, etc. all offer same day appointments, and/or walk in Sports Physicals for around \$35. This is a great option if a student can't get into their regular doctor before the season starts or they have insurance complications.

Step 3: PAY FEES ON-LINE THROUGH REVTRAK

Payment for participation in athletics is made through RevTrak. This is a one time fee for the entire school year and covers all sports a student-athlete participates in. Note: some teams may have additional team fees that are not collected through the athletic department.

- Set up an account or sign into your account.
- Select **Athletics** followed by **Pay to Participate**.
- Select the team(s) your athlete is interested in participating/trying out for. Please list the student's last name, first name, and grade for 2022-23 in the comment box and complete payment. Note that all SHS sports are not offered at SMS - choose the sport(s) in which you would like to participate based on what's offered at [Saline High School](#) and [Saline Middle School](#).
- All students must pay the Pay to Participate Fee before the first day of practice/tryouts for registration to be complete.
- The Saline Athletic Office will not accept any fees or payments in person. All payments must be made online through RevTrak..
 - Note: if a student gets cut from a Fall Sport and is NOT playing a winter or spring sport, a refund will be issued by contacting Tiffani Harris (harrist2@salineschools.org).

**** Non-Funded Varsity Sports** – *Equestrian, Field Hockey, Rowing, Bowling, Ice Hockey, Skiing, Lacrosse, and Water Polo* are all non-funded Varsity sport status. These teams collect their own team fees and SAS Pay to Participate fees are not applicable to these teams. All other sports (Middle School, Freshmen, JV and Varsity) are funded and require Pay to Participate fees ([Saline High School](#) and [Saline Middle School](#)). Community Ed activities have different fees.

Scholarship - If a child qualifies for the free or reduced lunch plan, he/she may qualify for an athletic scholarship. Step 4: New to the District / Transfer Student

If the following situations do not apply to you, skip this step! Most will not be completing this part of the registration process.

A MHSAA New Student/[Transfer Form](#) must be filled out by any student in 10th, 11th or 12th grade who is **new** to Saline Area Schools. Additionally, any 9th grader new to Saline Area Schools who enrolls after August 30, 2022 is a transfer student and would need to complete the [Transfer Form](#). Please return the completed form to the Athletic Director, Ashley Mantha (manthaa@salineschools.org) to make sure a student is eligible to participate in Saline Athletics this school year.
