- 3. Must have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 at the time of application.
- 4. Must have been accepted, or have made application to an accredited college, university, technical, vocational, or other accredited educational institution.
- 5. Must have participated in at least one of a Virginia High School League (VHSL) sport at the Varsity level at Stone Bridge High School for at least one season. Participation in club sports (non-VHSL sports) does not meet the eligibility criteria of this Program.
