All coaches must remain on site as Director unless another coach gives them a short break. Players/Parents *are not allowed* to run the matches or coach players.

12 schools participate in District III-5A: Boise, Borah, Capital, Centennial, Columbia, Eagle, Kuna, Meridian, Mountain View, Nampa, Rocky Mountain and Timberline.

Player Preparation

Players should plan to play 11 matches since this is a Round Robin Tournament.

Please encourage players to bring food, water, sunscreen, layered clothing and other necessities for staying at a single site all day.

Site Management

1. All tournament play will follow USTA rules and the district's code of conduct. No foul language, racquet abuse, ball abuse, uncooperative behavior or any other unsportsmanlike conduct will be allowed *on* or *off* the court. The site director/manager will be in charge of enforcing the USTA rules and district code of conduct. (*Verbal warning will be given to all players at the beginning of the tournament Saturday morning*).

a. 1st violation: Loss of point
b. 2nd violation: Loss of game
c. 3rd violation: Loss of match

- 2. Players MUST check in upon arrival to the courts in the morning. Players must also check with the coach in charge before they leave the site for any reason, including meal breaks.
- 3. <u>Warm-Ups</u>: 10-minute warm-up for the first match and 5 minutes for all matches that follow.
- 4. <u>Default</u>: Players that do not report to the courts 10 minutes after the match is called will be defaulted. *Site directors/coaches will not track down players*.
- 5. Coaching is allowed on each change-over except the change-over after the 1st game of the match; cannot exceed 1 ½ minutes.

Tennis Balls:

- Every school participating will provide 15 cans of USTA approved balls.
- Please send 1 can with your Boys Doubles to Mountain View HS and the other 14 to the site that you are managing.
- 2 new tennis balls will be issued to the first matches. Tennis balls can be used for 2 matches before they are changed out. When a team takes new balls please ask that they leave them by the net of their court when they come off. When a team uses balls found at the net please ask they bring those balls to the tournament desk when they come off.

Tournament Format:

Round Robin format. Each school (player or doubles team) plays every other school once. The school with the most wins is the champion. Ties are resolved by head-to-head matches. There is no championship round.

Match Scoring Format:

- 4-game pro-set with NO-Ad scoring.
 - o 7-point tiebreak at 4-4
 - o Please properly log all match scores (complete scores), not just W/L.
 - Winners and Losers from each match should ensure accurate scores are turned in to and properly recorded by the site director(s). As noted above, Site Directors compile the scores and points, reporting totals into the google sheet as play is completed. Players are responsible for verifying their scores with each other and the site director.
- Round Robin Points:
 - o 2 points for a win
 - o 1 point for a loss
 - o 0 points for a team or player that forfeits/defaults
 - o Place ties are decided by head-to-head match outcome in pool play.
 - o 3-way ties will be broken based on the least number of games lost.

Awards:

Team 1st place trophies awarded for boys and girls.
