Fans attending EHS events must adhere to the guidelines and protocols put in place according to the Governor's reopening plan and the EHS reopening plan. These specific guidelines include

- Practice physical distancing of at least six feet
- Wear face coverings when unable to physically distance
 - Outdoor spaces at EHS Face coverings recommended
 - Indoor spaces at EHS Face coverings required
- Stay home if sick
- Practice good hygiene
- Cover coughs and sneezes

Fan Attendance Guidelines per Sport

Varsity Football Games:

Each patron MUST have a ticket pass to enter the stadium. The tickets reserve your seats, however, you will still be charged admission to the event upon arrival per SIC ticket pricing. Tickets will ONLY be given to student athletes (varsity football players/band/cheer) to disperse to immediate family members. Each varsity football player will be given 4 tickets per home game prior to the event. Cheer and band members will be given 2 tickets prior to the event.

Visiting School – Each visiting school will receive 150 tickets for visiting fans (Visiting team administration will determine how they want to disperse those tickets). Fans are restricted to the bleachers and grass areas on the visitor's side.

Student Section – Student tickets will be limited availability on a first come, first serve basis for Emmett High School students ONLY. Tickets will be sold to the first 75 students with activity cards.

Freshman & JV Football Games:

All patrons will be allowed to enter with no limitations on fan participation. Normal SIC pricing for admission will be charged at the gate. Fans will still be required to abide by Stage 4 and ESD guidelines for events:

- Engage in physical distancing of at least six feet from non-family members
- Only allowed to sit by immediate family members.
- Wear face coverings when unable to physically distance
 - o Outdoor spaces at EHS Face coverings recommended
 - Indoor spaces at EHS Face coverings required
- Stay home if sick
- Practice good hygiene
- Cover coughs and sneezes

JV and Varsity Soccer Games:

All patrons will be allowed to enter with no limitations on fan participation. Normal SIC pricing for admission will be charged at the gate. Fans will still be required to abide by Stage 4 and ESD guidelines for events:

- Only allowed to sit by immediate family members.
- Wear face coverings when unable to physically distance
 - Outdoor spaces at EHS Face coverings <u>recommended</u>

Cross Country Meets:

All patrons will be allowed to enter with no limitations on fan participation at no charge. Fans will still be required to abide by Stage 4 and ESD guidelines for events:

- Engage in physical distancing of at least six feet from non-family members
- Only allowed to sit by immediate family members.
- Wear face coverings when unable to physically distance
 - Outdoor spaces at EHS Face coverings <u>recommended</u>
 - Indoor spaces at EHS Face coverings <u>required</u>
- Stay home if sick
- Practice good hygiene
- Cover coughs and sneezes

Volleyball Games:

All patrons will be allowed to enter with NO limitations on fan participation. Normal SIC pricing for admission will be charged at the gate. Fans will still be required to abide by Stage 4 and ESD guidelines for events. Fans will be asked to leave the gym after the conclusion of each sub varsity contest to allow the next group of fans to enter.
