CRITERIA FOR SELECTION INTO LAKELAND HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

Eligibility for student-athletes:

Eligibility Tiers for student-athletes based on following tiers in order of selection priority:

- ➤ Tier 1 Student-athletes meeting the Charter Class Criteria (see below)
- ➤ Tier 2 Student-athletes who may not meet Tier 1 criteria, but meet all of the following;
 - Graduation from Lakeland High School ten years prior to their nomination.
 - O Superior accomplishments as a student-athlete such as a long standing record, All-State honors, etc.
 - o Clear exemplified characteristics of integrity and sportsmanship, as well as citizenship before and after graduation.
- ➤ Tier 3 Student-athletes, who may not meet Tier 1 or 2 criteria, but meet one or more of the following.
 - Continued excellence at the collegiate, national, amateur, or professional levels.
 - Significant academic and post college career accomplishments.
 - Inspirational achievements such as fighting illness, overcoming obstacles, or leading someone in overcoming an obstacle.
 - Graduation from Lakeland High School ten years prior to their nomination.

Eligibility Tiers for coaches/administrators in order of selection priority:

- ➤ Tier 1 Coach meets the Charter Class Criteria (see below)
- ➤ Tier 2 Coach/Administrator who may not have met Tier 1 criteria but meets one or more of the following criteria:
 - o Significant contributions made to the overall athletic program including longevity, overall record, and championships.
 - o Significant contributions to the community or professional organizations at the state or national levels that promote ideals of student-athletes.
 - o Retired from position once held at LHS.

Charter Class Criteria

- Graduation from Lakeland High School ten years prior to their nomination or retired from position once held at LHS.
- Student-athletes who have become professional athletes or student-athletes who have completed their collegiate athletic careers at a Division I college or university.
- Coached multiple state championship teams in a given sport.
- Exceptional high school, collegiate or professional accomplishments.
