
Parker Honored

Warrior Run grad named PSAC East Rookie of the Year Standard Journal

BLOOMSBURG—Bloomsburg University softball player and Warrior Run product Taylor Parker was named the 2014 PSAC Eastern Division Freshman of the Year in voting by the conference coaches.

Parker, who was also named second team All-PSAC East as a utility player/pitcher, was joined on the all-conference team by Chrissy Belko who was named first team as an outfielder, while being named second team All-PSAC East were Erika Yanora at shortstop; Kayla McHale in the outfield and Sarah Bertoni as a designated player.

Parker became the Huskies ace in the circle early in the season and went on to a post a record of 14-8 with a 1.71 ERA. She leads the Huskies in wins (14), innings pitched (139), strikeouts (109), shutouts (5); and complete games (20). In last week's PSAC playoffs Parker went 1-1 tossing a three-hitter in getting the win over Gannon, then coming back and fanning a career-high nine in a 4-2 loss to eventual PSAC champion California (Pa). career start against Shepherd she threw a five-hit shutout striking out six and not issuing a walk.

When not pitching Parker moves to shortstop for the Huskies and is hitting .328 with four homers and 22 RBI. She is second on the team in doubles with 10 and is tied for the team lead in base on balls with 12. In last week's PSAC playoffs Parker was 5-8 with a double.

Bloomsburg is 27-17 and will make its 32nd straight NCAA playoff appearance on Friday when it takes on West Chester at 3:30pm at California (Pa).
