



BANGOR AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT ATHLETIC EVENT SAFETY GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES

Bag Procedure

Each guest is welcome to bring one bag into a Bangor Area School District athletic event, provided the bag is soft-sided and is for health or childcare needs (e.g., diaper bags, small purses, etc.) and its dimensions do not exceed 16 inches by 16 inches by 8 inches. Briefcases, coolers and other hard-sided bags or containers are not permitted. All bags will be thoroughly inspected before they are permitted into the venue. There is no storage area for any items that do not meet security requirements.

Ejection

Guests who refuse to follow the direction of BASD Event Staff & Security or who do not comply with the guest Code of Conduct face ejection, without refund, and revocation of season tickets and/or future ticket privileges and may also be in violation of local and/or state ordinances, resulting in possible arrest and prosecution.

Entry and Carry-In Procedure

Inspection points have been established at all BASD Athletic Event entrances. The Bangor Area School District reserves the right to inspect any bags, clothing, or other articles prior to entry into the venue and prohibit entry or require removal of any items at their sole and absolute discretion.

NOTICE: For the safety of every guest, any person or property that could affect the safety of the venue, its occupants, or its property shall be denied entry. Guests may bring into the venue one soft-sided bag, clear in nature preferred, no larger than 16 inches by 16 inches by 8 inches.

Guests may NOT carry in the following items:

- Any bag larger than 16 inches by 16 inches by 8 inches
- Briefcases, coolers, or other hard-sided bags or containers
- Glass, cans, aluminum bottles, thermoses, or any outside beverage container except for containers for feeding infants.
- Laser pens
- Any type of ball
- Firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind
- Illegal drugs or substances
- Alcoholic beverages
- Brooms, poles, staffs, or sticks
- Baseball bats of any size
- Animals (except service animals to aid Guests with disabilities)
- Air horns or other distracting noisemakers
- Any devices that may interfere with and/or distract any sports or event participant, other Guest, audio or audio/visual telecast or recording of the game or event, or any technology-related service provided in the Venue

(OVER)

- Masks or costumes
- Projectiles (e.g., Frisbees, beach balls, etc.)
- Confetti or glitter
- Fireworks
- Obscene or indecent clothing

Such items will be prohibited from being brought into the venue. There is no storage area for these items. Guests arriving by public transportation should take particular care not to bring any prohibited items, as no exceptions will be made.

Game-Day Access Tips

Inspection points have been established at all venue entrances, and guests and their belongings may be searched. To expedite entry and assist Event Staff & Security, guests should abide by the following recommended guidelines:

- Arrive when gates open to avoid lines and to enjoy pregame venue activities.
- Have ticket or payment in hand.
- Remove headwear upon entering the inspection area; it will be screened.
- Unzip and open coats, jackets, purses and/or bags upon entering the inspection area.
- Refrain from bringing any items on the prohibited items list.
