Bus Parking

- Upon arrival, athletes should be dropped off at the northeast side of the building and use Door #7 to enter the school. Busses should park on the northeast side of campus near the baseball field.

Locker Room

- Due to Covid restrictions and limited availability, there will be no locker rooms provided for visiting teams. Please have athletes come prepared to compete.

Benches

- Each team will be assigned chairs for the event. **Individual teams should take their chairs with them to the next mat if they are traveling.**

Masks
