- Parking – Expect a parking fee anywhere near the stadium
- Spectator Entrance – use Gate B (Gates A & G are also available)
- Seating – sections 125, 126, 127, 128, and 129
  - When arriving early, please sit in the end zone until the conclusion of the Division 5 Game
- Student Section Seating – section 124
- All tickets are \$20 and seats are General Admission
- 2,000 presale tickets are available for purchase by cash or check (made payable to DHS):
  - Monday in the Athletic Office from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
  - Tuesday in the Athletic Office from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
  - Friday from the High School North Entrance (Door #8) from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m.
- Tickets will also be available for purchase by cash or credit card at Ford Field on Saturday
- No passes accepted (including Senior Citizens)
- Tickets will get spectators in for all games – Divisions 7 (10:00 a.m.), 1 (1:00 p.m.), and 5 (4:30 p.m.)
- No Re-Entry
- The following general policies apply to spectators at MHSAA Tournament events
  - Tunnels for players by spectators, band or others (but not cheerleaders) at any location and any level of MHSAA tournament play is prohibited
  - Air horns, whistles, megaphones, and speakers are not allowed
  - Body paint is not allowed
  - Spectator Videotaping – Spectators may tape the event from their normal seating area but are not to interfere with the view of other spectators or news media personnel covering the activity
- Use of alcohol or tobacco, including e-cigarettes or other smoking devices, is prohibited at MHSAA tournament events by players, coaches, and spectators
- Teams participating in MHSAA Tournaments are prohibited from streaming live video of any portion of an event over the internet—including using social media platforms like Periscope and Facebook—or any other method
  - Likewise, individual spectators are also prohibited from streaming video through any means
- No tailgating (i.e. grills or alcohol of any kind) are allowed in parking lots by city ordinance

- DHS Spectator Bus:
  - Bus is available for DHS students only
  - Sign up in the HS Athletic Office
  - \$25 due at the time of sign up
    - \$20 cost of game ticket
    - \$5 deposit to be refunded the day of the game
  - Permission Slip & Release Form are to be turned in during one of the days of ticket sales
    - Forms will NOT be accepted on Saturday
  - Bus departs from the DHS North lot at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 27
    - Bus is expected to return to DHS at approximately 1:00 a.m.
  - There is no additional cost to ride the Fan Bus
    - The cost of the bus is being generously paid for by a DeWitt community member
  - Bus expectations:
    - Masks are required at all times
    - No food or drink on the bus (except for water)
    - DPS Code of Conduct applies
    - Students MUST ride the bus down AND back (no exceptions)

- Ford Field Rules
  - No mask requirements
  - Only handheld signs are allowed (no sticks)
  - No posting signs on stadium walls or hanging banners
  - No confetti or paper pompons on sticks
  - No bottles, food, coolers, jugs, etc.
  - Personal items (bags, etc.) will be checked for bottles, etc.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS DURING MHSAA FOOTBALL FINALS

The items not permitted into Ford Field, stadium plaza areas, stadium gates, or when approaching queue lines of guests waiting entry into the stadium are strictly enforced during stadium events. Prior to gate entry, guests should return prohibited items to their vehicles. Ford Field is not responsible for any items left at the gates or in the trash receptacles. Under no circumstances will the items be checked at the gates. Prohibited items may also be confiscated by staff. Guests should come prepared to show keys, cell phones or other metal items in their hands during the screening process. Please follow all signage and direction from security personnel. Early entry is encouraged. As a reminder, smoking is prohibited inside of the stadium. This includes the use of electronic cigarettes and vaporizers. Ford Field reserves the right to expand or modify the prohibited items at any time.

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MAY BE PERMITTED AFTER INSPECTION:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"  
One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)
- Small clutch bags, camera & binocular cases, not exceeding 4.5" x 6.5", with or without a handle or strap, can be taken into the stadium with one of the clear plastic bag options. For more information, visit [www.nfl.com/allclear](http://www.nfl.com/allclear)
- Medically necessary items including insulin, medication, portable oxygen, small soft pack coolers and breast pumps
- Infant items in a clear bag (bottles, formula) are allowed with a child. Diaper bags are not allowed per the NFL bag policy
- Small radios (must be used with an earpiece or headphones)
- Umbrellas, small compact only. Must be placed securely under the seat.
- Handheld posters & signs without poles, sticks or battery operated. Must not block another guest's view.
- Football helmets. Altered helmets equipped with spikes or any other item that can be used as a weapon are not permitted
- Tablets (iPads, Kindles, etc.) Inappropriate subject matter should not be displayed & must not block another guest's view
- Small diaper bags (only if accompanied by a child)



### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO):

- Aerosol cans (hairspray, mace, pepper spray, etc.)
- Animals (except certified service animals to aid guests with disabilities)
- Backpacks, luggage, grocery & paper bags, duffle bags, large bags, large purses or large camera cases
- Balloons (air or helium)
- Balls (beach balls, footballs, etc.)
- Banners or large flags
- Cameras with lenses longer than five inches or any detachable lens
- Decals, stickers, confetti or glitter
- Drones and/or remote controlled aircraft
- Electronic equipment including laptop computers, video recorders, tripods and wearable video cameras including Go Pros.
- Fireworks
- Food, beverages or liquids (cans, bottles, boxes, flasks, etc.)
- Illegal substances
- Knives, pocket knives, box cutters, scissors, etc.
- Laser pointers
- Markers (permanent) and/or paint
- Noisemaking devices (bells, horns, kazoos, whistles, etc.)
- Objects that can be used as missiles or projectiles (sticks, poles, bats, clubs, Frisbees, etc.)
- Offensive or profane messages or images on signs and clothing that are distasteful or indecent
- Seat cushions or chairs
- Selfie sticks
- Strollers and infant car seats or carriers
- Umbrellas (large size)
- Weapons\*
- Wrapped gifts



\*No weapons are allowed in the stadium. Possession of a firearm or any other weapon is strictly forbidden. Possession of such a weapon will result in immediate confiscation, ejection and possible arrest. Per the NFL, only sworn on duty law enforcement officers acting in their official capacity working at Ford Field are able to carry a weapon.
