

## Here is a look at the Butler Wrestling Team in 2017-18

## 2017-2018 Team Highlights

- 2017-18 Dual Record: 8W-8L. Section 3A 3<sup>rd</sup> place, Section 3 -6<sup>th</sup> place
- Section 3 5/6 place match lost to Shaler 43-32, missed qualifying for the WPIAL Team Tournament for the first time in 11 years.
- Chartiers-Houston Tournament 7th, 27 teams 1. South Fayette 158, 2. USC 155, 7. Butler 118.5. Butler placed 5 individual wrestlers at Char Houston.
- Southmoreland Holiday Classic Tournament 4th, 26 teams 1. Greensburg Salem 214, Freedom 165.5 West Allegheny 144.5, Butler 130. Butler placed 6 individual wrestlers at Southmoreland.
- William Jenkins Duals 2nd, 1st Greater Latrobe 10 teams Butler 4W-1L.
- Penn Trafford Tournament 2nd place, 11 teams 1. Bell Vernon, 2. Butler, 3. Mt Pleasant, 4. PT
- The team will return 9 of 14 starters in the 2018-2019 season.
- Five members of this year's team had two or less year's experience, the most inexperienced team I have ever coached in 25 years.
- Coach Stoner moved to 343 wins and 168 losses, and is 3rd in wins among active coaches, and 10th on the WPIAL all-time list.

## 2017-18 Individual Highlights

- The 2017-18 Team qualified 5 individuals for AAA WPIAL Individual Tournament, 3 of the 5 WPIAL Qualifiers will return in the 2018-19 season. Place winners were Christian Sequete 1<sup>st</sup> at 182, it was Christian's second section title, and 4<sup>th</sup> time qualifying for the WPIAL Tournament. Jack Codispot placed 3<sup>rd</sup> for his third trip to the WPIAL Tournament. Freshman Nate McMaster was 4<sup>th</sup> at 120, Freshmen Clayton Dressler was 5<sup>th</sup> at 106, and Senior Robert Hays was 5<sup>th</sup> at 160.
- Sequete went on to the WPIAL Tournament where he defeated two-time WPIAL Champion Tim Wallace of Albert Gallatin 9-2 in the finals. Sequete had lost to Wallace two times previously during the season.
- Sequete went on to the PIAA State Tournament and lost his first round match. He then won his next five matches before losing and placing 4<sup>th</sup>. In the process he avenged his first round loss against his Shikellamy opponent. He also defeated two other regional champions.
- Sequete also placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at Chartiers Houston, 1<sup>st</sup> at Southmoreland, and 2<sup>nd</sup> at Penn Trafford. He compiled a 39-5 record, had 23 falls, finished with 107 career victories, and was selected the "Team Most Valuable Wrestler".
- Christian was also selected to represent the MAC Conference against the OVAC All-Stars where he recorded a fall.
- Junior Jack Codispot 145-152 pounds, placed 3<sup>rd</sup> at Chartiers Houston, 3<sup>rd</sup> at Southmoreland and 2<sup>nd</sup> at Penn Trafford. Jack finished with a 31-7 record, had 20 pins, and has a 79 and 32 career record. For the third time Jack won the team's "Pride, Attitude, and Guts Award".
- Senior Robert Hays finished the season with a 19-14 record in his second year. Robert won only one match his first year and earned the team's "Most Improved Wrestler Award" and the team's "Outstanding Character Award".
- Senior Justin Stewart went 20-7 and was one of 6 wrestlers that recorded 20 or more wins. Justin also Placed 5<sup>th</sup> at Southmoreland.
- Sophomores Colton Spohn 120-126, and Nate McDonald 138, each fell upon poor fortune sustaining injuries that sidelined each of them for the post season. Colton Paced 5<sup>th</sup> at Southmoreland and Nate placed 6<sup>th</sup> at Chartiers Houston.

- Butler started three freshmen who all recorded 20 or more wins. Clayton Dressler 106, went 20-16 and qualified for the WPIAL Tournament. Clayton placed 8<sup>th</sup> at Southmoreland. Nate McMaster 120-126, went 24-15 recording 17 pins, and qualified for the WPIAL Tournament, going 2-2 at WPIALs. Nate also placed 6<sup>th</sup> at Southmoreland and was awarded the team's "Darkhorse Award". Steven Green 132, went 28-12 with 15 pins and led the team in takedowns with 62. Steven placed 3<sup>rd</sup> at Chartiers Houston, and 6<sup>th</sup> at Southmoreland. Steven won the team's "Outstanding Newcomer Award".
- Butler forfeited several weight classes each match and additionally had five wrestlers with less than 2 year's experience in the line-up.
- The combined record for the three graduating seniors was 78W-26L.
- There were 16 wrestlers on the roster in 2017-18, the lowest number of participants since 1993. There were 3 seniors, 4 juniors, 6 sophomores, & 3 freshmen on this year's team.
- Butler was coached by Scott Stoner (25), Fred Powell (8), and Trevor Gallo (1)
