- The Varsity Girls Volleyball earns the FML League Championship.
- The Varsity Girls Volleyball Team won its District championship.
- The Varsity Volleyball team advanced to Regional Semifinals and lost to Utica Eisenhower.
- The Varsity Girls Golf Team earns co-champion status for the FML.
- The Girls Golf Team earns MHSAA District Championship.
- The following members of the Varsity Cross Country team competed at MHSAA State Finals: Dominic Dimambro, Jacob Lee, Mitchell Chabot, Luke Chabot, Noah Day, Isaac Moore, and Andrew Bond.

- Cambria Tiemann competed in the Division 1 MHSAA Cross Country State Finals after qualifying individually in the Regionals. Cami competed in the MHSAA Division 1 Cross Country State Finals. There were 55 freshman out of the 242 runners in the D1 finals and Cami came in 42nd place out of all freshmen and 194th place overall.
- Varsity Volleyball wins their MHSAA District Title and advances to MHSAA Regional.
- The Varsity Football team advanced to District Football Playoffs against Midland Dow.
- The Varsity Girls Swim Team wins their 12th consecutive Flint Metro League Championship. Fenton won 11 of the 12 events at this meet. Individual event winners were Bri Costigan, Elise Cassidy, Cameron Mathews, Caitlyn Dailey, Emma Cagle and Taylor Shegos.
- Taylor Shegos set a Brandon High School record, a Fenton Varsity Record and a Flint Metro League Record with her score of 460.55 in 1 M Diving.
- The Varsity Boys Cross Country Team placed 9th overall at the MHSAA Division 1 State Finals.
- Individually Fenton had three All State placers: Jacob Lee in 19th place, Dominic Dimambro in 23rd place and Andrew Bond in 26th place. Rounding out Fenton's finishers: Luke Chabot at

149th, Nolan Day at 215th; Samuel Strickhouser was 231st and Mitchell Chabot was 244th. There were 248 runners in the boy's finals. This was the first time in school history that Fenton has had three All State Runners in the same season for Boys Cross Country.

- Boys Cross Country Team wins their first MHSAA D1 Regional title; third place in all divisions.
- Dylan Crankshaw had a Football Team Record for 214 rushing attempts

- The Varsity Football Team rushed 2,317 yards in a single season
- The Varsity Football Team had the highest scoring average of 41.4 which is the sixth all time high
- The Varsity Football Team scored 290 points in a season; the 2012 Varsity Football team was the only other team with more points
- Kevin Lack had a 90 yard TD catch against Swartz Creek and tied for 4th in the league
- Greg Lukas had 31 PAT's in a season and tied for 5th in the league
- John Cryderman was named Flint Area Bowler of the Year
- Four wrestlers advanced to MHSAA Regionals: Mario Ramirez (112), Jake Church (140), Tommy Adams (145) and Andrew Goodman (285).
- Ms. Zoe Weinberg advanced to MHSAA State Ski finals and took second place in the Slalom and third place in the Giant Slalom.
- Ms. Zoe Weinberg was named First Team All-State. In addition she was second place in the Slalom and third place in the Giant Slalom. Ms. Weinberg was the only skier to place in the top three in both the Slalom and Giant Slalom events. She also ran the fastest overall time combined in these events.
- Mr. Brenden McInerney advanced to MHSAA State Ski finals and came in 41st in the Giant Slalom.
- All Divisional Skiers in the Giant Slalom were Brendan McInerney, Tom Kemp, Zoe Weinberg, and Ashlyn Smith.
