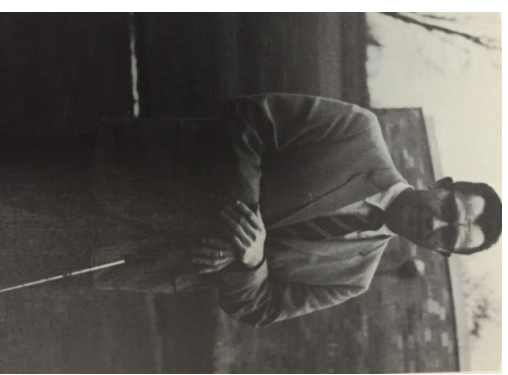

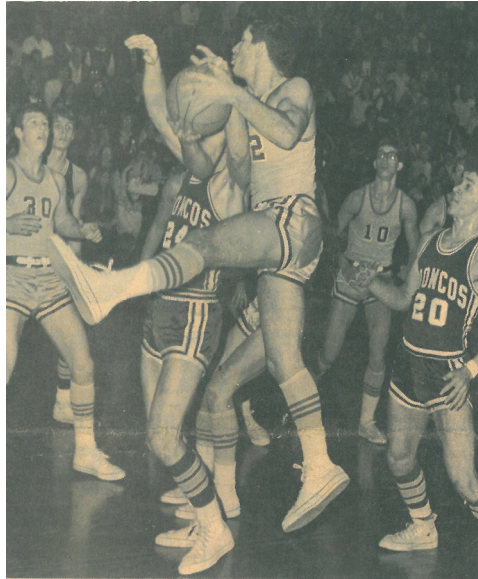

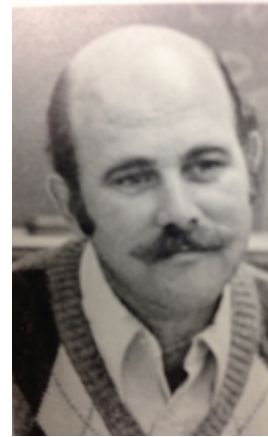
### Mike Nelson GHS Class of 1969

#### Teacher/Coach 1968-1998

Duane graduated from Cadillac High School in 1955. He earned his Bachelor's degree in 1968 from Central Michigan University after serving four years in the Army. He taught social studies for 31 years at Greenville High School.

Duane was a much-beloved and respected wrestling coach at GHS for 21 years from 1968 to 1989, the last 16 years as head coach. After his coaching years, were over he continued to volunteer for many years. He started a youth wrestling program in the 1970's and a J.V. wrestling tournament and Greenville Holiday Tournament that continues to this day. Duane coached two State Champions during his tenure, as well as numerous State qualifiers.

He was also head boys golf coach for four years from 1996-2000, and assistant for seven years; and as was an assistant football coach for 12 years.
