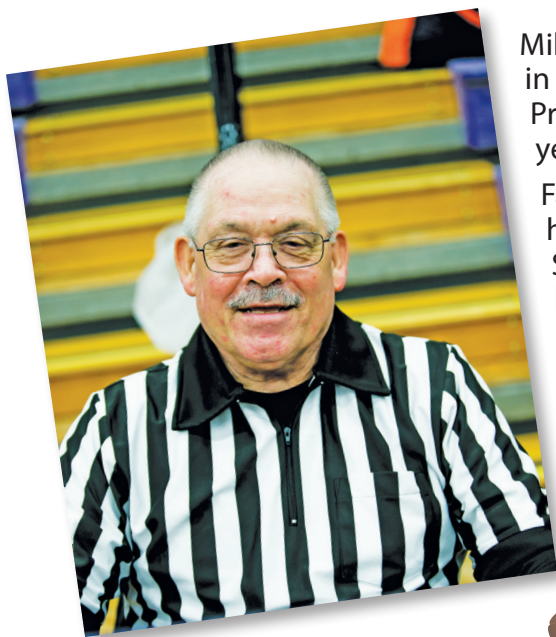

Family: Married to Angela; three children, Nolee, Mitchell and Shelby.





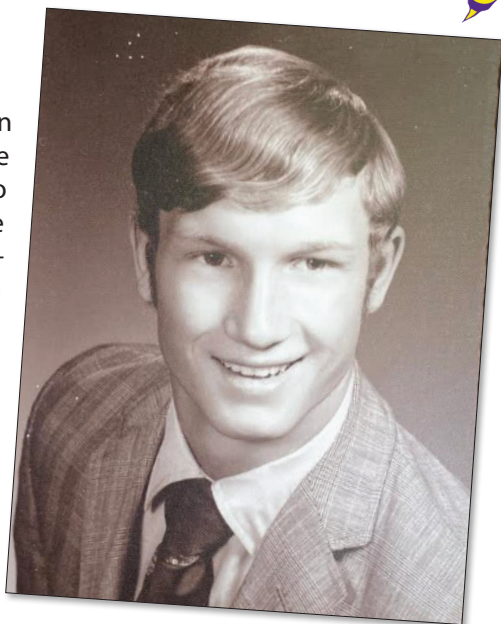


## **Jeff Day**

### **GHS Class of 1971**

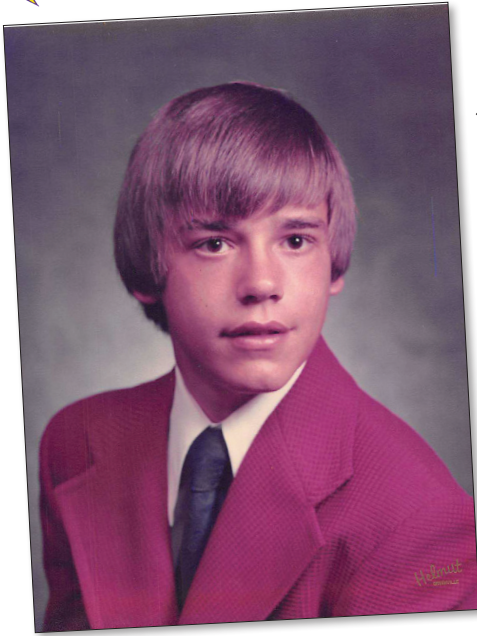
Jeff graduated in 1976 from Western Michigan University with a degree in Sports Medicine. He returned to Greenville to teach and become one of the state's first certified and school-sponsored athletic trainers at the high school level. Jeff was also an assistant baseball coach from 1978-1982 and wrestling coach from 1986-1990.

Known affectionately as "Doc" Day, he worked tirelessly for 41 years at GPS to teach and keep our kids healthy and safe. He retired in 2017. He was the recipient of the prestigious School Bell Award. There was no one more passionate about student athletes than Jeff. His quiet, calm demeanor was a source of comfort and reassurance to kids, coaches, and parents. He cared for athletes seven days a week and every weekend. It is estimated that Jeff has treated more than 27,000 athletes working approximately 70 hours a week.

Jeff has been an avid and relentless supporter of Greenville Public Schools and all-things athletics for over 45 years. ### **GHS Class of 1961**

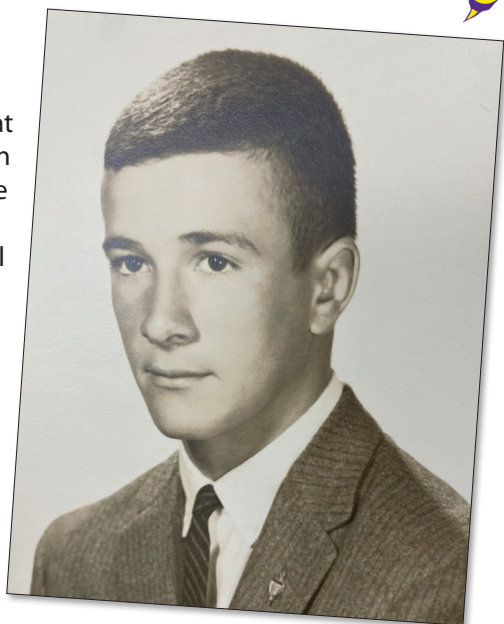
Bruce was a three-sport athlete at Greenville High School, competing in football, basketball and tennis, where he finished with an impressive 19-1 record. He later coached varsity football in 1963 and 1964 and again from 1981 through 1984, when the team finished with an impressive 9-0 record. He again coached freshman football in 2007.

Bruce worked with fellow Hall of Fame honoree, athletic trainer Jeff Day, at all football games for 15 years. He was affectionately known as the school's "oldest water boy."

Bruce was a two-time School Bell award recipient for Greenville Public Schools.

Bruce graduated from West Michigan Law Enforcement Academy in 1962. He worked for the city of Greenville for 47 years, retiring in 2007 as Director of Public Safety. After the Columbine tragedy, Bruce went to the high school every morning at 6:30 a.m. to check the entire building and to greet students. His love for the students of Greenville Public Schools was well known and appreciated by the community.
