


Shawn Borich

As a member of the class of 1990, Shawn earned 8 Varsity letters in Soccer and Track & Field. During his time with the soccer team, Milford won the 1986 NOSL Championship. On the track, Shawn was a part of two Kensington Valley Conference Championships in 1989 and 1990. Shawn excelled in the hurdles and was a 2-time KVC runner up in the 120-yard high hurdles while qualifying for the MHSAA State meet in 1989. He also finished runner-up in the 330-yard low hurdles at the KVC Conference meet.



After graduating from Milford, Shawn went on to attend Albion College and earn four varsity letters in Track and Field. While at Albion Shawn earned all-conference honors in 1992 and 1994 as the MIAA 110-meter high hurdle champion. He reached the elite level when he qualified for the NCAA Division II national qualifier in the 110 high hurdles with a 14.76 in 1994. He was a member of two MIAA conference champion teams in 1993 and 1994. Shawn had an illustrious career at Albion which earned him a spot in the Albion College Athletic Hall of Fame.

Shawn did not only excel on the track but also in the classroom. While at Albion he majored in Biological Anthropology before earning a master's degree in health management and policy from the University of Michigan. He went on to earn his medical degree from Michigan State University's College of Human Medicine in 2000. After finishing medical school, he relocated to Richmond, Virginia to complete his Emergency Medicine Residency at Virginia Commonwealth University.

He is currently the Senior Vice President and Group Medical Officer for a large physician staffing company and the co-owner and founder of a growing Mid-Atlantic Urgent Care chain. He is also an entrepreneur and investor involved in multiple medical and technology start-up companies and serves on the boards of several diverse and charitable entities. In his free time, he enjoys playing soccer and tennis (albeit poorly), photography, traveling with his family and complaining about taxes and politicians.
