

Viking Five at Portage Friday . . .

Glendale Has Four Vets

COALPORT — Coach Joe Vesnesky would like to have another week to prepare for an opener, but his Glendale Area High cagers are rarin' to go.

The Vikings start their 20-game schedule Friday at Portage with four lettermen in the lineup.

They are seniors Dick Braniff (6-1), Roy Peacock (6-2) and Rick Rydbom (5-11) and junior Jim Tiesi (5-11). Non-lettering junior Jim Yingling (6-0) will be the other starter. He played in seven varsity games late in the 1965-66 campaign.

Tiesi, the third leading scorer with 238 points, and Peacock, who tallied 211, were regulars last season. Braniff (58) was the top reserve in the frontcourt and Rydbom (53) in the backcourt.

Behind Tiesi and Rydbom at guards are seniors Gary Frisco (5-8) and Tom Evansky (5-9). George Lucas (5-11) and Bob Tokarchic (6-0), both seniors also, will play at forwards.

Other players are seniors Ken Miller (5-10) and Bob Matish (5-8) and junior Pat Andrews (6-1).

Tiesi, Braniff, Rydbom and Lucas attended a summer camp for basketball and Braniff, in particular, is much improved.

"He's been a delightful surprise," said Vesnesky. "He

handles the ball well for a big man. Tiesi will be where we need him most and always seems to come up with the play when you need it. Rydbom is going to be our playmaker."

Last season the Vikings were 5-17, including a 4-4 log in the Moshannon Valley League. They lost the top two pointmakers, Barry Mihalko (313) and playmaker Tony Pino (256) and the other guard, Tom Cossick (181) and reserve Greg Scott.

Vesnesky is hoping for at least a .500 season and figures his team will challenge for the MVL title.

"We're going to give them a real good run," he remarked. "It's the biggest team in overall height that I've had here and I can't get over the air of confidence the boys have.

"It looks like another dog-fight in the league. It looks like Moshannon Valley is going to have a dandy team and you know Curwensville will be tough. Coach (Jim) Sybert's crying the blues at Harmony and that's a bad sign. West Branch gave us trouble last year and is better this season."

Vesnesky ranks Williamsburg, Juniata Valley and Portage as the toughest of the Vikings' non-league opponents.

George Mills, a Moshannon Valley High and Lock Haven

State College graduate, is the new assistant coach. His junior varsity team includes sophomores Gary Sinclair (6-1), Jim Duke (5-11), Bob Reynolds (6-0), Dick Evansky (5-6), Dave Cunningham (5-10), Pat Pino (5-7) and Bernie Slovikosky (5-10) and freshmen Mike Hesson (5-5), Tom Morrison (5-7), Gary Kizina (5-11), Nick Cherish (6-6), Duane Smeal (5-7), Joe Gresco (6-2), Larry Kaufman (5-10), Tom Nash (5-4) and Dave McClellan (5-6).

Glendale Loses 6-C Playoff, 65-62

Glendale, which appeared to have the biggest group of rooters, outhustled the Green Hornets in a bid to atone for 71-42 and 90-69 losses to the Huntingdon County five, but the ball just wouldn't drop through the hoop for the Vikings.

Coach Joe Vesnesky's team, 10-11 for the season, hit only 10 of 41 shots in the second half for 24 per cent. The Vikings were able to match the Green Hornets in scoring for the last two periods but did it in the final eight minutes after allowing the winners to go in front by 10 points in the third stanza.

For the game, Glendale connected on 26 of 74 flings at the hoop for 35 per cent while Juniata Valley canned 29 of 73 for 40 per cent.

Terry Simkins and John LaPorte each scored 17 points to pace the Hornets while Larry Dick contributed a dozen markers.

Four Vikings hit double figures, topped by Dick Braniff's 16 points. Jim Tiesi collected 13, seven below his average, Roy

Peacock bagged 11 and Jim Yingling added 10, six below par. Tiesi (14) and Peacock (13) and Braniff (11) accounted for most of Glendale's 54 rebounds.

The Moshannon Valley League champs led three times early in the game — 4-2, 7-5 and 9-7 — but were ahead only once more, 34-32, late in the first half.

Juniata Valley was beating the Vikings under the boards and breaking LaPorte free on fast breaks for easy layups. When they set up against the Viking zone, the Hornets often worked the ball into Simkins, who seemed all alone under the bucket.

Coach Ed Sparr's team used a fullcourt zone press that troubled the Vikings briefly but pulled out of it in the second period.

The turning point came in the third period. Leading 45-41, Juniata Valley scored the next eight points for a 12-point bulge and Glendale never recovered.

The Vikings, sparked by Gary Frisco, cut the deficit to 59-54 with 4:51 left and 61-56 with 3:20 to go but couldn't get closer until Braniff converted two fouls and Peacock hit a fielder that set the score at 64-60 with a mere 36 seconds remaining. Ron Eichelberger then iced it for the Hornets with a foul toss.

Juniata Valley refused to go into a control offense with the big lead in the last period and turned the ball over many times, only to regain possession when the Vikings erred or missed easy shots.

"The kids gave 100 per cent," Vesnesky said. "We completely out hustled them. I think they underestimated us and didn't think we'd come back the way we did. We just didn't take advantage of it. We missed too many shots and had too many turnovers. We threw the ball away entirely too much.

"We might have stayed in our zone a little bit too long but anyone who saw us play man-for-man would know why. Maybe if they would have gone into a freeze we would have pressed but we were getting the ball as it was.

"Every team is going to throw the ball away. Every team is going to make some mistakes. We just made too many.

"I've never seen a ball club like ours. Our record isn't indicative of the kind of team we have. These kids are capable of beating anybody on a given night and I'd have taken my chances against Williamsburg Friday.

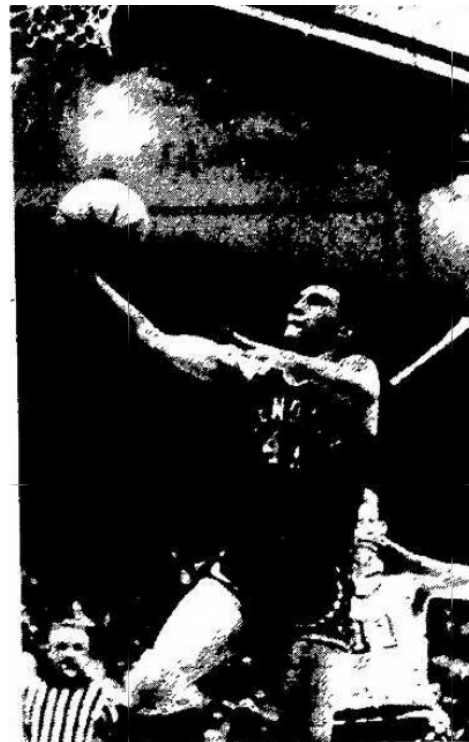
"We had a lot of tired boys back there after the game. They gave it their supreme effort. They really did. They have nothing to be ashamed of."
