# Top Scorers Tiesi, Yingling Key Glendale Hoop Fortunes

COALPORT — Even with scoring aces Jim Tiesi and Jim Yingling for openers, Glendale Coach Joe Vesnesky is apprehensive about the upcoming basketball campaign, his fourth as Viking mentor.

"I just can't seem to find the right combination," he said. "Our first game is only a few days away and I know as much now as I did Nov. 1. I just hope we're ready."

The Vikings, defending champions in the Moshannon Valley League, launch a 21-game schedule Friday in a home test with Portage.

Tiesi, a 5-11 senior who scored 428 points last season and was a unanimous pick for the All-MVL team, and Yingling, a 6-0 senior who collected 346 tallies, probably will have to top those figures if the Vikings are to have a successful season.

"We don't have the shooters we did last year," Vesnesky added.

Only 6-0 junior Gary Sinclair is assured a starting role with Tiesi and Yingling, both two-year lettermen.

Vesnesky is banking on 6-3½ soph Joe Gresco in the pivot and hoping that 5-6 soph Dwane Smeal, 5-5 junior Pat Pino or 5-8 junior Bernie Slovikosky can do the job as playmaker.

"They're fighting neck-and-neck," he said. "It's just a big tossup. If Gresco doesn't come through, Pat Andrews could be a sleeper. He could be our ace

in the hole.

"As Yingling and Tiesi go, so go the Vikings this year. It looks like that kind of a season."

Andrews is a 6-3 senior who saw action in several games in 1966-67 but didn't score.

Other varsity players are 6-2 Bob Reynolds, 6-1 Jim Duke, 5-8 Dick Evansky and 5-7 Don Kitko, all juniors.

"We've been stressing defense ever since we started practice," Vesnesky added. "Then in our only scrimmage we couldn't put the ball in the basket so I told the kids we were going home and shoot for three weeks. We're trying all kinds of defenses but will stay mostly in a zone."

As the MVL champs, the Vikings will be the target for all of the league teams, Vesnesky feels. He looks for a dogfight with his team right in the middle of it.

Glendale, which will participate in the West Branch Tournament with Curwensville and Bellefonte, has its work cut out also in the non-league action with the likes of Bishop Carroll, Portage, Blacklick Valley and Juniata Valley on the schedule.

The Vikings were 10-10 last season before losing to Juniata Valley, 65-62, in the District 6 Class C playoffs

Rebound stalwarts Roy Peacock (271) and Dick Braniff (232) and playmaker Gary Frisco (82) were the key players lost from that team along with reserves Rick Rydbom (78), Bob Tokarchic (43), Tom Evansky (22), George Lucas (12), Ken Miller and Bob Maish.

Newcomer Gary Gruver will guide the Viking jayvees and has junior Gene Noel (6-0) and sophomores Larry Rydbom (6-1), Nick Cherish (5-6), Dave McClellan (5-7), Tom Nash (5-5), Mike Hasson (5-9), Carl Travis (5-9), Larry Kaufman (5-11), Tom Morrison (5-10), Jim Mellrath (5-10), Gary Turner (5-9), Dave Hamilton (5-6), Dave Rayhocki (5-11) and Mike Dudurich (5-9).

George Mills, last year's jayvee coach, will tutor Glendale's first junior high team.

# Glendale's Tiesi Sets Career Mark

COALFORT — Glendale came up with third quarter problems for the third consecutive game and dropped a 90-81 decision to Blacklick Valley last night.

The Vikings fans saw senior Jim Tiesi set a B-C-I - Glendale career scoring record of 1,078 points in three years. Tiesi had 21 points last night to cap a 417-point senior year. He netted 232 his sophomore year and ripped the cords for 429 his junior campaign.

Tiesi, who won the Moshannon Valley League scoring crown last year with 162 points and again this year with 172, pulled in 10 rebounds and had five assists for a fine all-around night.

Almost overshadowing Tiesi last night was the fine all-around effort of Dick Evansky. Evansky hit six straight field goals at the start of the fourth period to pull the Vikings to within two points of the visitors 89-78. He wound up with the night's high point performance of 27.

The other Viking player to score in double figures was Gary Sinclair. He had 14 points.

The Vikings shot 38 per cent from the floor by hitting on 33 of 85 field goal tries but the Blacklick five took less shots (72) and made the same (33) for a 46 per cent night from the hardwood.

Rebounding was close, too, as the Vikings pulled in 37 and Blacklick Valley had three more (40).

The big story of the game was on the free throw stripe where the Vikings connected on 15 of 27 charity tosses compared to 24 of 38 by the winners.

Tiesi and Joe Gresco both fouled out with four minutes remaining in the game and Sinclair left two minutes later.

The loss of those three players was the Vikings' downfall because they just couldn't get the rebounds the rest of the game and didn't have much scoring punch either.

The contest was the last of the year for the Vikings who finished with four victories and 17 defeats.

Blacklick Valley also finished the regular season but wound up 15-7. They are slated for a Northern Cambria League playoff game with Bishop Carroll Saturday night for the Section A title.

George Yokitis led the winning Blacklick cagers with 26 points. Jeff Price was next in scoring with 18 markers, while Ron Rufano chipped in 16 and Bob Martin 11 to round out the scoring.

In the junior varsity tussle, Blacklick Valley also came out the winner by a 61-33 count. Larry Rydbom had 10 points for the Glendale jayvees.
