# Vikes Have Problems

FLINTON — The way Glendale's all-underclassmen starters played in the second half of the 1970-71 cage season, Coach Joe Vesnesky couldn't help but look to the future.

The outlook isn't nearly as bright now, however.

Two of the returnees, senior Jeff Best and junior Sam Tiesi, have been unable to join their teammates in practice because of football injuries. Best, a two-year vet who was the No. 2 scorer last winter with 78 points, may be back soon. Tiesi, who was fourth with 197 points is a question mark. The playmaker is in a body cast because of vertebrae problems.

Still, Vesnesky has three good holdovers in John Vigne (259 points last season), Mike Tiesi (199) and Steve Dudurich (47). The latter played the last nine games but just missed earning a letter.

In preseason scrimmages, Vesnesky went with those three plus Bill Andrews and either Lyle Kizina, Jim Dick or Jack Keith. Tim Mihalko, who worked hard over the summer, will play a lot, too.

"I told the boys that they're gonna have to play just like they didn't have Jeff and Sam," Vesnesky said. "It's tough to replace lettermen. Actually, how do you replace them?"

"I think the boys we have will come through. They are

working hard. There's always been spirit at Glendale. I know we've been down three or four years but it's no detriment to our enthusiasm. The kids feel they're a good club and they are ready to go.

"Our schedule is one of the toughest we've had in years, especially since we're competing in two leagues."

The Vikings, who open Friday at home against Clearfield St. Francis, are the newest members of the Northern Cambria League Section B. Harmony, Penns Manor and Northern Cambria are the other teams.

Glendale also vies in the Moshannon Valley League.

"There are no breathers for us," Vesnesky said. "We'll have our hands full with all of them."

Chief losses from last year's team due to graduation were early season starters Bill Dubler (127 points) and Rick Miles (54).

Vesnesky is assisted by Tom Terza and George Mills.

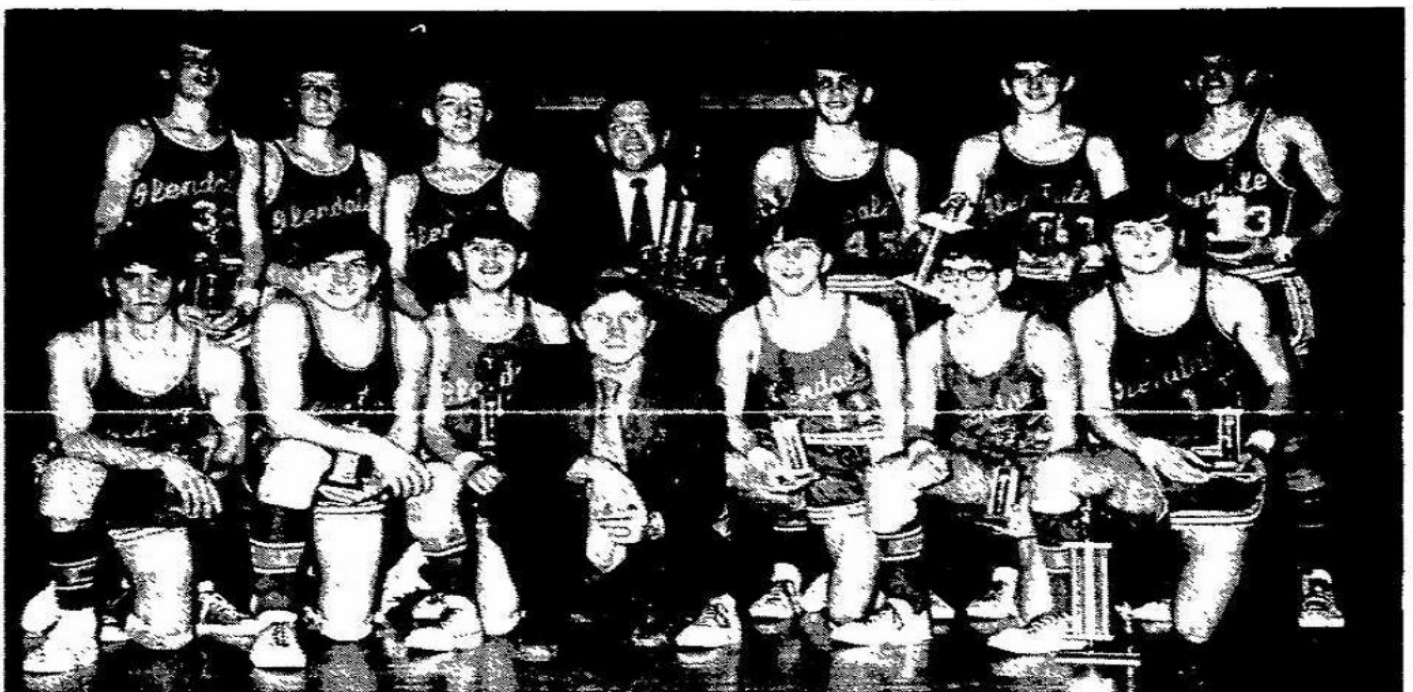

# Cold-Shooting Vikings Bow

TYRONE — When it comes to basketball, no team hustles more than Glendale.

But last night the hustle wasn't enough.

Coch J. Vesnesky's tireless Vikings failed to connect on the high-percentage shots against heavily-favored Juniata Valley in an opening round game of the District 6 Class C Playoffs, and the cold shooting resulted in a 49-41 loss.

As disappointed as the Viking players, coaches and fans were with the outcome, they were equally frustrated by the fact that the ballgame could have gone their way. Very easily.

When a team shoots a mere 25 per cent from the floor and scores its second-lowest total of the entire season — and still only loses by eight points, well, you can't blame the players for thinking they have rotten luck.

Glendale, which went into the contest a severe underdog against the talented Green Hornets, finished up the year at 11-12. The Vikings are better than that.

Last night's contest marked only the fifth time all year the Vikings were held below 50 points, and only the 37 points they scored against Clearfield St. Francis was a lower total.

Juniata Valley came into the game at 19-3 and it appeared that the Hornets were suffering from a slight case of over-confidence in the early stages.

Neither team was particularly sharp in the first quarter, but there was a difference in styles. Glendale simply wasn't hitting the good shots while Juniata Valley was taking poor ones.

Unable to penetrate the Vikings' match-up zone defense, the Hornets bombed away from outside with little success.

The ballgame was scoreless — and the fans were restless — until Mike Tiesi netted a free throw with 3:19 left for the first point. Denny Anders finally put the Hornets on the board with 2:47 showing by canning a layup.

The period ended in favor of the Juniata Valley crew, 10-6.

The teams battled evenly through most of the second act, but the Hornets put together a strong closing burst to carry a 25-17 lead at the intermission.

Early in the third canto, John Vigne swished a long jumper to open Glendale's attack. After that, however, the Vikings got just one free throw while the Hornets opened the spread to 30-20.

Late in the quarter Bill Andrews dropped in a hook shot. Jeff Best canned a free throw. Tim Mihalko hit from the gift

stripe and Vigne converted a 1-and-1 as the Vikings climbed back to within 32-26 at the buzzer. The Hornets were finally convinced they were not going to run away from Glendale.

The Vikes, who did a terrific job on the boards against a taller team, continued to shut off Juniata Valley's second attempts, but couldn't get their own offense rolling.

Following a free throw by Denny Anders, Glendale turned two turnovers into four points on buckets by Andrews and Best to cut the gap to 33-30 with five minutes remaining. That was as close as the Vikings were to get.

Anders keyed the Hornet offense with two buckets and a pair of free throws while Glendale got a three-point play from Steve Dudurch and a layup by Tiesi to stay within striking range at 41-37.

With 2:15 left, however, Anders provided the knockout blow with a three-point play. Seconds later Bill Anders came up with a tap-in to make it 46-37. It was all over.

"I don't think we took the game to them in the first half," commented Vesnesky. "We didn't run the way we normally do."

"I thought our kids did a commendable job on the boards. They hustled, but our

inside shooting wasn't up to par and some turnovers hurt us, particularly late in the first half when they built a lead.

"These kids are a bunch of hustlers, though. They didn't quit. They're a great group of kids."

Andrews, one of five underclassmen who saw action for Glendale last night, led the team in two departments as he posted 11 points and the same amount of rebounds. The Vikes showed a 47-45 edge on the boards.

Denny Anders was the player who saved the Hornets from being erased. He scored 20 points — most of them in the second half — and also grabbed 20 rebounds. He is a very good player. Bill Anders, who favors shots that scrape the ceiling from the outer limits, added 13 points to the cause. The Hornets shot a not so hot 33 per cent, so they couldn't have been very satisfied with their performance either. Undoubtedly, they're better than they showed.

It was the last game for Vigne, Best, Tiesi and Luke Kizina, who, along with Mihalko, offered a good performance coming off the bench. The underclassmen on the squad told anyone who came within earshot that they'd be back again next year.

Nobody offered any doubts that they will.
