With five letter winners back, Nagel expects big things from Vikes

FLINTON — Experience.

Third-year Glendale head boys' basketball coach Eric Nagel points to that as the main strength of his 2003-2004 squad.

The Vikings return five letter winners — seniors Bill Peoples, Scott Laing, Derek Kauffman, Kevin Hollis and junior Mark Lyons — this season as well as several younger players who did get some varsity playing time last year.

"We have the core of our team back," Nagel said. "All the letter winners started at least a few games for us last year. It's a great nucleus to have — a great asset. And a lot of our younger kids saw some time last year as well. The kids understand what needs to be done."

Peoples was a Progressland Second Team All-Star last season. He averaged 12.5 points per game (good for second on the Vikings, behind 1,000-point scorer Shawn Krestar) and 6.2 rebounds per game, while also swatting a Progressland best 2.7 shots per game.

Laing (6.0), Lyons (5.4), Kauffman (4.4) and Hollis (2.0) were fourth through seventh on the team, respectively, in scoring.

Nagel says that the team has been working very hard in practice, and he has been pleased with what he's seen throughout the preseason.

"Our practices are upbeat," Nagel said. "It's been a good two

weeks. The kids deserve a lot of credit. The intensity is up, especially on defense. In both our scrimmages, we came out and established ourselves defensively."

Glendale, which finished with an 8-17 record last season, will once again compete in the Moshannon Valley League and the Mountain Athletic Conference, which was formerly known as the Juniata Valley League.

"We want to compete for the Moshannon Valley League title," Nagel said. "But there are lot of good teams out there. Harmony and Mo Valley return a lot of good players. Mo Valley has (Steve) Holencik and (Matt) Belella back. Harmony has (Jason) Romagna back. West Branch and Curwensville have quite a bit back too. It's going to be a wide-open league."

In the Juniata Valley League (now Division 3 in the Mountain Athletic Conference), Penns Valley is probably the team to beat. Our goal is to show up night in and night out and play the best we can."

Nagel feels to be successful this season, his squad will need to become a better fourth quarter team.

"We have to work on winning games," he said. "We lost a lot of games in the fourth quarter last year. We need to learn how to finish games off."

While the Vikings do return a number of players with starting experience, Nagel was not ready

to name a starting lineup just yet.

"We've been working on a lot of different things with a number of different lineups," Nagel said.

The Vikings will open their season Tuesday, hosting rival Moshannon Valley in an MVL and MAC tilt.
