# Glendale boys basketball optimistic about 2006-07 season

FLINTON — The Glendale boys basketball team finished last season with an 11-14 record overall and a 3-5 mark in the Moshannon Valley League.

The Vikings return four letterwinners — senior Gary Walstrom Jr. and juniors Brock Kauffman, Brett Hullihen and Sam Yingling — to this year's squad and head coach Gregg Mazenko is optimistic as to what his team is capable of this season.

"I think with this group that they have the expectation of winning," said Mazenko. "It's hard to teach that mentality and that mind set, and they already have that so it's going to help out tremendously."

"We've played with a lot of energy, and our guard play has been pretty strong. Hopefully, we can build off that energy."

While Mazenko returns some experienced players, the Viking coach will have to replace the top two leading scores from last season in Bill Ball and Shane Krestar. Krestar was also the team's leading rebounder, which is Mazenko's chief concern entering the 2006-07 campaign.

"We're small, so we're not going to have the luxury of relying on one guy just to pull down the rebounds because he's taller than everybody," Mazenko said. "We're going to have to box out

as a unit and kind of rebound with a chip on our shoulder. Hopefully, we'll be successful if we do that."

Walstrom is the team's leading returning rebounder, pulling down 160 boards last season. Yingling also had a strong sea-

son on the boards a year ago and finished the season with 155.

Walstrom and Yingling have two of the starting positions, and Mazenko noted the duo has taken a leadership role upon their shoulders.

"Gary is pretty vocal and

encouraging in practices, and Sam is kind of warming up into that role a little bit," said Mazenko. "Gary has taken the definitive leadership role, but we'll see if anyone else will step up even further."

Hullihen, Kauffman and

Ethan Hullihen have the other three positions secured. Sophomore Vance Kimberly will also see a considerable amount of playing time.

"I told them on the first day that I already had a projected lineup," Mazenko said, "and that if it was going to change, it was going to be up to the guys under that."

"This group has won in elementary, in junior high they won, in jayvee they won, and now they're varsity, and I think their expectations are to win. So, to put a number on that, I don't really know. We'll look to improve on last year's record and have a winning record."

Mazenko has 13 players in all on the roster, compiled of four seniors, five juniors, three sophomores and a freshman.

The Vikings will be competing again in the MVL and the Juniata Valley League.

Glendale enters the season hoping to be highly competitive in the MVL, and Mazenko knows the level of competition his squad will face.

"Harmony's still going to be very deep and talented. I expect Curwensville to be there as well, along with West Branch. The thing about Mo Valley is they are young, but they're going to start a bunch of sophomores — with last year, though, they're going to be experienced sophomores. I don't see anyone in the league

that's going to be a pushover where you can just walk in and expect to win."

The Vikings open their season next Friday at the Harmony Tip-Off Tournament against Austin.

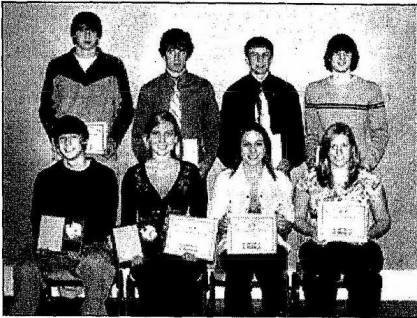
