

September 23, 1967: Claysburg 20 at Glendale 6

Claysburg Bops Glendale, 20-6

IRVONA — The hard running of Bulldog halfback Jeff Lingenfelter keyed a strong ground attack that powered visiting Claysburg-Kimmel to a 20-6 win over the Glendale Vikings here Saturday afternoon.

Glendale is 1-2 while Claysburg-Kimmel is 1-1-1.

The Vikings, playing without the services of quarterback Jim Tiesi and lineman John Heverly, were simply unable to match the visitors on the ground.

The Bulldogs controlled the ball throughout most of the contest, rushing for 244 yards while their aggressive defense allowed Glendale only 15. Lingenfelter carried for a big 166 yards in 27 tries; the victors went to the air only three times.

Art Helsel put Claysburg out in front early in the first quarter when he climaxed a 55 yard

drive with a four-yard TD run up the middle. The extra point was booted by Lingenfelter.

Later in the stanza, Alan Claycomb snared a Viking aerial on the C-43. A clipping penalty on the runback put the ball on the C-28, but Lingenfelter breezed 72 yards to paydirt around the right end and booted the placement to give the Bulldogs a 14-0 edge which stood until halftime.

Claysburg took the second half kickoff and just kept grinding out the yardage, scoring late in the period on a four-yard run by Bill Richey. The PAT kick was wide to the right.

The Vikings averted a white-wash late in the final quarter. Skip Gressinger got the home team started when he recovered a Bulldog fumble on the G-23. Glendale quarterback Larry Rydbom tossed two 20-yard passes to Gary Kizina on consecutive plays to get the Vikings

within striking distance, and Pat Pino tallied four plays later on a two-yard quarterback sneak with only five seconds left to play. The conversion kick was blocked.

The Vikings will be on the road Saturday when they take on Black Lick Valley.

Tiesi Paces Glendale Past Purchase Line 15-6

IRVONA — Quarterback Jim Tiesi came off the injury list to lead Glendale's Vikings to a 15-6 Homecoming victory over winless Purchase Line here Saturday afternoon.

The senior quarterback scored one touchdown, passed for another and booted one extra point as the Vikings snapped a five-game losing streak with their second win of the year.

A spectacular second period pass play gave the Vikings a 7-0 edge at the half.

Glendale, which travels to Williamsburg Friday night, got the ball on its own 11 after Purchase Line ran out of downs. On second down, Tiesi hit Gary Kizina and the speedy left end did the rest on an 89-yard TD. Tiesi placekicked the PAT.

Early in the third period, Viking John Heverly got off a 55-yard punt to the P-5. Two plays later, a Red Dragon pitchout went awry and Tom Beatty recovered in the end zone, Bob Reynolds tackling him for a safety.

Coach Stan Bem's Dragons made it interesting at the start of the fourth quarter on a 57-yard scoring aerial from Gary Langham to Jim Neely. A bad snap spoiled the PAT try, but the Dragons trailed only 9-0.

Tiesi's one-yard sneak midway through the quarter clinched the win. The fourth down play came after John Heverly recovered a Dragon fumble on the PL-7. Tiesi's conversion try was low.

Lloyd singled out Heverly's defensive play and punting as a bright spot for the Vikings and also lauded Tiesi's effort coming off the injury.

Top ground gainers in the defensive struggle were Tiesi with 61 yards in 12 carries and Purchase Line's Dexter Fyock with 50 yards in 10 tries.
