RENOVO — Glendale scored 31 fourth-quarter points to overcome an 8-7 deficit as it blew out host Bucktail, 38-8, on Friday night in Renovo.

With the win, the Vikings ended the 2003 season at 3-7. Bucktail — which has dropped three of its past four — fell to 6-3.

"The kids played well tonight," said Viking head coach John Kutz. "We were down in the fourth quarter, and it was the like the kids just said 'Hey, this is it.' They just went hard and were able to pull it out."

Glendale got a big game from Alan Collins, who rushed for 261 yards on 19 carries. He also scored three TDs. Scott Laing had a solid night throwing the football, completing 10-of-18 for 106 yards and a touchdown.

The Vikes got on the board first. In the opening frame, Andrew Bennett scored from 17 yards out with 7:47 left to make it 7-0.

That was the way it remained until the third quarter, when Bucktail got on the board. Dustin Newlen scored from seven yards out and also ran in the two-point conversion as the Bucks took the lead, 8-7.

"Dustin had a couple of big runs in the third quarter," Kutz said. "Besides that we were able to shut him down pretty good the rest of the game."

However, the fourth quarter was all Glendale.

The Vikes re-took the lead on a 9-yard pass from Laing to Kevin Hollis. It came with 10:17 to play in the contest and pushed Glendale back out in front, 13-8. Then, Collins took over. He scored on runs of 37, 57 and 37 yards to blow the game open. Bennett, who finished with seven carries for 46 yards and two scores, got Glendale's final TD of the night, bursting in from four yards out.

Glendale outgained Bucktail, 405 yards to 182. The Vikes got the win despite turning the ball

over four times.

"We turned the ball over early and that hurt us," said Kutz. "But it was a good win for us, because everyone was involved. Hopefully, we can carry that over into next year. If the kids work hard in the offseason, we can get this program to the next step."
