Kutz, Glendale finally break into win column

SAXTON — The Glendale football team came into the seventh week of the scholastic season with an 0-6 record.

But, four of its last five losses came to teams — Northern Bedford, Juniata Valley, Moshannon Valley and Chestnut Ridge — with a combined 23-1 record.

With their toughest stretch of the schedule behind them, senior tailback Alan Collins and his teammates looked towards this week's matchup with Inter-County Conference foe Tussey Mountain as an opportunity for a victory.

The Vikings took their first step in finishing up respectably, notching their first victory of the season with a 35-18 win over

Tussey Mountain on Friday night in Saxton.

"This victory means everything to us," Collins said. "Every one came out and stepped up, and it feels good to get this win."

"Obviously it's a great win," Vikings head coach John Kutz said. "I'm just so proud of the kids."

The win raised Glendale's record to 1-6 overall, while the Titans' fell to 0-7.

Glendale got on the board early when Bobby Hewitt caught a 79-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Derrick Strong.

Cody Morningstar answered the Vikings' touchdown with a five-yard scoring run of his own, but the PAT failed.

Collins, scored a 17-yard touchdown run to give the Vikes a 14-6 lead, but Morningstar cut the Titans' deficit to two, when he scored on a 35-yard run with

less than three minutes left in the first half.

The Titans were able to move the ball on the ground in the first half—tallying an even 100 yards—but the Vikings' defense tightened up and held the Titans to just 26 yards rushing in the last 24 minutes of the game.

The Titans didn't score again until a desperation heave by Morningstar was caught by Josh Eichelberger while time expired in the game.

"Our defense played about as well as they could play," Kutz said. "The defense really stepped it up in the second half."

The Vikings offense wasn't exactly prolific against the Titans, but it did make enough plays to win. Strong only completed two passes, but the one did go for a first-half touchdown.

Glendale was able to control

the game with its running attack, which reached 150 yards on 37 carries. Collins led the attack with 89 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 23 carries: Collins credited his solid performance to the offensive line doing its job.

"It feels great to have a game like this, and it feels great to win," Collins said. "The offensive line came out all fired up, and they blocked so well. The line really busted its tail out there."

The Vikings will try to make it two in a row next week against West Branch, a team they lost to 7-3 a year ago.

"If we keep improving, I don't think this will be our last win," Kutz said.

Tussey Mountain coach, Nate Nace, was unavailable for comment.

Glendale travels to face the Warriors on Friday.
