

Glendale pastes Williamsburg By Jon Fleck

For The Progress WILLIAMSBURG - Coming off last week's 10-point loss to Moshannon Valley, Glendale head coach Michael Keith wanted to see better play out of the defensive line.

He got it. Anchored by big Shawn Brink, the Vikings defensive line dominated the line of scrimmage Friday against Williamsburg at War Memorial Field.

Throw in a handful of big plays on offense, and it all adds up to a 30-0 win over the Blue Pirates. Glendale improved to 3-2 on the season. Williamsburg remains winless at 0-5.

"The defensive line really stepped up this week," Keith said. "They didn't play too hot last week. We really challenged them this week."

Subtract a 25-yard run by Garrett Harstrom on the game's final play, and the Glendale defense gave up just 57 rushing yards on 35 attempts.

"Their defensive line played well," Williamsburg coach Bob Hearn said. "We had trouble containing (Brink). He was up and down the line making plays."

The 6-foot-4, 280-pound senior led the charge not only against the run but the pass as well. When the Williamsburg quarter-backs did get a pass off, it was for a short gain.

Starting quarterback Jed Dishong left the game midway through the second quarter after being sacked by three Glendale defenders and did not return.

Backup Austin McMonagle didn't fare much better, completing just three dumpoffs to running back Alan Shanholtz over the charging defensive line.

Glendale quarterback Gary Witherow had a much better night, however. Witherow helped the Vikings grab an 18-0 halftime lead with two touchdown passes and a touchdown run.

Following a 1-yard sneak for a touchdown late in the first quarter, Witherow connected with Jarid Ivory on a long scoring play to open the second quarter when the junior quarterback found Ivory wide open in the right flat on third-and-3.

Ivory slipped a tackle along the sideline and went the distance for a 52-yard touchdown and a 12-0 lead.

possessions Two later. Witherow connected downfield with Doug Twigg for a 27-yard touchdown.

For the game, Witherow com-pleted seven of 10 passes for 116 yards

"They keying were (Damon Braniff) so we had to throw the ball to loosen them up," Keith said. "When you can throw and run, the defense doesn't know what to stop.

Williamsburg got a big dose of Braniff in the second half, however.

The junior tailback scored on runs of 50 and 65 yards to set the final score. He finished with 166 yards on 17 carries.

We had trouble moving the ball and made some mistakes defending the pass," Hearn said. "It's all stuff we've been focusing on and need to get better at.

Glendale hosts Juniata Valley on Friday.
