# Jasper sparks Vikings in Braniff's debut

FLINTON — Glendale junior quarterback Jacob Jasper couldn't have envisioned a better individual performance prior to the season opener against Williamsburg on Friday night.

Glendale coach Richard Braniff couldn't have envisioned a better first game as coach of the Vikings.

Jasper, a 6-foot, 150-pounder, threw for 218 yards and two touchdowns to running back Shane McMurray, and he ran for two more scores in the first half to lead the Vikings to a 35-17 win over the Blue Pirates at Dr. Roy F. Baker Field.

"I did all right. I feel like I could have completed some more passes if I sat in the pocket a little longer," Jasper said. "I didn't expect (the 218 yards passing) at all."

"I can't say enough about Jacob," Braniff said. "He kind of took the reins there, kind of put the team on his shoulders. He played real tough."

Afterward, Braniff was soaked after getting doused with water by his team, and he couldn't have been happier.

"I'm feeling good," Braniff said. "That's a great group of kids. I've coached them at different levels, pee-wee, junior high, and I told the

kids I'm glad I got the opportunity to do it again because they're smart football players with big hearts. They believe in themselves. If they continue to work hard, I think we're on the right track."

"They outplayed us," Williamsburg coach Bob Hearn said. "They were a much better team than we were tonight. Give Coach Braniff credit. He had them ready and playing hard."

Jasper's first pass was intercepted by Nick Michelone, and that led to a Michelone 22-yard field goal with 5:05 left in the first quarter.

But then Jasper took over in the passing game. He completed 3-of-4 on a 64-yard drive that ended with a 31-yard touchdown pass to McMurray.

The Blue Pirates regained the lead with 4:50 left in the first half when senior quarterback Rashad Knorr, who had 22 carries for 67 yards before leaving the game with an apparent arm injury, ran 9 yards for a touchdown.

On the ensuing possession, though, Jasper completed five passes, including a 12-yard jump pass to McMurray to the Pirate 40 for a first down. Five plays later, Jasper scored from the 1 with 2:21 left.

The Glendale defense stiffened and forced the Pirates to punt. Knorr was harassed all night when he went back to pass by Isaac Krause, including the third-down pass that gave the Vikings the ball back at Pirate 41 with 1:55 left in the half.

"Isaac Krause is an animal," Braniff said. "He has a motor like you rarely see in high school football. He's not going to give quarterbacks any time to pass."

Jasper immediately connected with David Rydbom for a 22-yard play, and after his own 6-yard gain, he scrambled to his left, cut around defenders and took a hit by Chandler Gunnnett as he crossed the goal line on a 13-yard TD run with 39.2 seconds left.

"The one had a lot to do with my running back, Shane McMurray," Jasper said. "I was going to throw it to him, but he told me to tuck it and go, so I just followed him."

"He gave it all he had to get in that end zone," Braniff said. "He wanted it. He was hungry for it. These kids are all hungry for wins."

At the end of the first half, Jasper had completed 9-of-15 passes for 146 yards.

"It just kind of happened,"

Jasper said. "As the game went on, I kind of took over, and they started calling some more pass plays. It makes you feel great. It makes you feel that you're the guy that they want with the ball in your hands. Luckily, we were connecting tonight."

"Our plan wasn't that," Braniff said. "We had a little bit of trouble getting our inside run game going, so we decided to spread the field a little bit. It was a very good choice to do that. I've got to give kudos to all of my assistant coaches. They were just phenomenal."

"He played real well," Hearn said. "We couldn't keep him in the pocket. He'd get out of the pocket and make plays running the ball and throwing. I knew he was a pretty good quarterback. I watched their scrimmage last week, and he threw the ball pretty well."

Down 21-10 at half, the Blue Pirates got closer in the third when fullback Grant Mikesic took over running the ball. Mikesic, who had 101 yards rushing on seven carries, scored on a 53-yard run with 7:05 left in the third.

But the Vikings pulled away as Jasper got the play calls to pass. At the end of the third, he connected on three passes that set up McMurray bolting 46 yards for a TD 46 seconds into the fourth.

Jasper finished off the scoring by tossing a 31-yard TD pass to

McMurray with 2:13 remaining.

Asked if he hopes that kind of performance happens a lot this season, Jasper said with a smile, "That's the plan."

Next up for the Vikings is Bellwood-Antis next Friday at home.

"It's good to have that confidence on our side rolling into Bellwood," Braniff said. "I'm looking forward to the challenge."

## Claysburg loses victory due to ineligible player

The Claysburg-Kimmel High School football team is off to one of its best starts in more than a decade, but it entered Friday's game at Juniata Valley with one fewer win than it had to enter the week.

The Bulldogs were docked 110 points this week because an ineligible player got into the game for Claysburg in Sept. 23's 55-29 homecoming victory against Glendale. The forfeit dropped C-K from 4-2 to 3-3.

Claysburg self-reported the mistake to the District 6 committee, which acted on the situation at Tuesday's board meeting.

"(Claysburg-Kimmel) also presented a plan to the committee to help ensure that a repeat does not occur," D6 chairman Dave Crumrine said. "In reporting that in our minutes, the District 6 committee also commended the administration of Claysburg for the sportsmanship, integrity and professionalism that led them to self-report."

The Mirror reached out to C-K athletic director Brian Heisel and Bulldog football coach Dan Foor about the situation. They directed questions to superintendent Steve Puskar, who offered the following statement via email.

"We support and respect the decision of the District 6 Committee, and have no further comment," Puskar said.

The discovery could have far-reaching effects in the District 6 Class 1A playoff picture. Claysburg entered the week in a strong position to host a first-round game as one of the top eight seeds, but the Bulldogs slipped into a tie for seventh place because of the forfeit.

Glendale, meanwhile, picked up its second win, moving the Vikings from 15th place into 10th in the D6 standings. Were it able to maintain that position, Glendale would make the playoffs, probably knocking out Bishop Carroll or Blacklick Valley.
