"Sophomore Lilley Vereshack provides a great spark coming off the bench, she's a pure athlete and I look for good things from her."

Coach Campbell says she will look to a combination of her senior letterwinners Mulhollen, Smeal and Lumadue to be starters, along with Lukehart, Reese and Campbell.

Campbell said her team strengths are strong outside shooting, good ball handling and a strong presence under the net.

The team has been focusing its work on being aggressive on defense.

Coach Campbell says, "it is a work in progress."

The teams goals are to be competitive in every game and to strive for a .500 season and a playoff appearance.

"I am very happy through pre-season and scrimmages how unselfish and team oriented these girls have been," said Coach Campbell. "If they continue that, I foresee a great season."

Campbell will be assisted by Jim Campbell.

Glendale opens its season on Dec. 14, traveling to West Branch.
