New Mat Coach at Glendale Has Seven Lettermen

FLINTON — Think about this for a minute: Glendale won two varsity matches in its first year of wrestling last year.

Now think about that. Two wins are hardly something to raise the roof about, but it marks tremendous progress for a team that had started the sport just one year previously.

New head coach Pat Pino will have seven lettermen back from last year's 2-10 team to try and lead the Vikes to a good season against a rather stiff schedule, all things considered.

"We're hoping to improve on last year's outlook," said Pino. "Our main goal is to improve year-by-year. We've come along fairly well these past couple of years."

As a team, the Vikes have come along as well—better, in fact—than can be expected. Individually, there are two grapplers that stand head and shoulders above the rest in more ways than one.

Heavyweight Denny Swauger, an outstanding athlete at whatever he does,

finished last year's season with a tremendous 10-0-1 record and 14-2-1 over-all. His only losses came in the District 6 Class AA Tournament against some of the finest heavyweights in the region.

Zane Hullihen, back for another go at 185, compiled an 8-7 record, but only his and Swauger's mark were good for winning percentages.

The other five lettermen are Dave McNelly (105 pounds, 5-10), Ron Troxell (112, 0-10), Mark Ricketts (138, 2-11), Terry Wills (132-1-4) and Bill Snyder (155, 3-10-1).

"We're pretty well inexperienced," continued the first-year mat mentor. "As you can probably tell, we lack depth. Our seven lettermen have only two years of wrestling experience and we're going to have five freshmen in our first six weights."

Indeed, Pino will be using a relatively young line-up when the Vike grapplers open their season Saturday at Ferndale in a basketball-wrestling

doubleheader. The mat action begins at 6:30 p.m.

Only McNelly, a junior, breaks the string of freshmen that crop up in the lower weight classes. Going down the list, it will be Tim Traveny at 98, Tim McCoy at 105, McNelly at 112, John Weymers at 119, Dave McGarvey at 126 and Wendell Westover at 132. However, some of the freshmen who wrestled in the junior high program last year had fine records.

The heavier weights are a little more stable. At 138 will be Ricketts, Wills will step in at 145, Snyder holds down 155, newcomer Edsel Delorme, a senior that played basketball up until this year, is at 167 and Hullihen and Swauger remain at 185 and heavyweight, respectively.

"Zane and Denny had our only two winning records last year," noted Pino, who was assistant under Jim Barto last year, "and we're expecting good seasons from them this year."

"We came close last year to

winning a number of meets," he continued, "Forfeiting '98 all the time really hurt us. But these kids kept on hustling and we should improve."

Proof again that Glendale athletes are winners right down the line.

Southern Huntingdon's wrestling team romped to a 47 - 11 victory over visiting Glendale Tuesday night.

The Rockets took a 47 - 0 lead before Glendale salvaged the final two bouts of the card. Southern goes to Tussey Mountain (8 - 4) Thursday night with a 6 - 5 - 1 record.

Steve McCardell (12 - 3) started the ball rolling for the Rockets by pinning Tim Traveny in just 31 seconds after getting a quick takedown. McCardell now has six falls on the year.

Tim Greenland (3 - 11) held off Tim McCoy in the third period at 105 to win a 9 - 6 decision. Greenland had a nearfall in the second round and took a 9 - 2 lead into the final two minutes before McCoy rallied with a reversal and predicament.

Harry Sieczkowski had a nearfall in the second period and a reversal in the third round while giving up a late escape.

Doug Witt (8 - 4) returned to action at 119 and nipped John Weymers 5 - 4, scoring the deciding two points on penalty assessments. Weymers also scored two of his points via the penalty route.

Craig Greenland (9 - 4 - 2) posted his first fall at 126, decking Dave McGarvey at 1:09 of the second period. Greenland held a 6 - 2 lead at the time.

Jack Byers (13 - 2) has become somewhat of a specialist in quick falls. He rolled over Terry Wills in just 23 seconds at 133 last night for his seventh pin of the season. Byers has a perfect 12 - 0 record in dual competition.
