Two PIAA Placewinners Among Eight Vets...

Vikings Have Potential for Banner Year

FLINTON — When you talk about Glendale High School wrestling this season, you have to start with Jim Orichosky and Tom Ross, both of whom placed fifth in the 1985 PIAA Class AA Championships at heavyweight and 167 pounds, respectively.

Orichosky has anchored the Viking lineup since his freshman year and owns a career mark of 84-12 with 48 pins, setting school records for career wins and pins.

Ross, like Orichosky a

three-time letterwinner, has a career slate of 69-22-2, with 12 of the losses coming his freshman year. He has pinned 32 foes.

"Ross and 'O' have been looking really good," said Glendale coach Blair Packer, beginning his eighth season. "When Jim was a freshman, he weighed 210 and moved pretty well. Now he weighs 235-240 and he moves better than he did at 210."

"Tom is getting over a concussion from a three-wheeler accident, so he hasn't been practicing lately, but I don't expect that to affect him too much. He has an awful lot of talent."

"I really get excited about them."

This season, Packer has a few more grapplers to get excited about, like seniors John Peacock, who was 20-2 last season at 155; Chris Henry, who was 19-9 at 167-185; and junior George Ginter, who was 17-9 at 112-119.

Those five give the Vikes a solid nucleus, along with lettermen Aaron Lewis, 5-13 at 98; Tim Renninger, 4-16-1 at

105-119; and Jeff Doughty, 3-11 at 132.

"Our first four weights are questionable, with not much experience and no depth," said Packer. "Our middle weights should hold their own, and the upper weights should do more than hold their own."

The Viking upper weights are so competitive that senior Steve Doughty, 4-2 last season, knocked Henry out of the 167-pound slot for the Tri-County League Tournament, which opens the Vikings' season tomorrow at Glendale.

"We have quite a few kids in the middle and upper weights and that makes for good eliminations," said Packer.

"And we have kids at every spot this year. Some of the kids are untested yet, but from 126 up everyone has had some varsity experience."

"A lot of the kids have been pushing harder than they normally would because of the leadership of Ross and Orichosky."

The Vikes will start the season with a lineup of sophomores Joe Storm at 98, Lewis at 105, Nick

Miseirvitch at 112, Dan Sanders at 119, Ginter at 126, Renninger, a junior, at 132, soph Joe Gates at 138, Jeff Doughty, a junior, at 145, Peacock at 155, Steve Doughty at 167, Ross at 185 and Orichosky at heavyweight.

The tourney, showcasing Bellwood-Antis, Juniata Valley, Tussey Mountain, Claysburg-Kimmel, Everett, Northern Bedford, Penn Cambria, Central and defending champ Portage and runner-up Vikings, gets under way at 6:30 p.m. tomorrow with preliminaries and quarterfinals.

Saturday action begins with the first-round of consolation and the championship semifinals at 12:30 p.m. The consolation finals are slated for 6 o'clock and the championships at 7.

"We missed the team title by two points last year," Packer said. "We've been climbing up the Tri-County ladder each year."

"I'd like to see us win the Tri-County tournament and get off to a good start, especially since

Glendale is hosting the tournament.

"It looks good but you never know. Barring injuries, we could have the best year we've ever had."

Vikings Win 31-30 Squeaker

SIDMAN — A pair of forfeits, including one at heavyweight, helped the Glendale Vikings nip the Forest Hills Rangers 31-30 in a Tri-County League scholastic wrestling match last night.

Coach Blair Packer's Vikings registered two falls, a major decision and a regular decision in boosting their record to 3-1.

Joe Storm started the visitors off with a fall at 98 pounds, pinning Jerry Roduck in 3:31.
