

Glendale sets school dual meet record with win over Mo Valley

AMESVILLE — The Glendale wrestling team solidified its position for District 6 Duals and set a new standard for wins in a season Tuesday night — and it did it against its biggest rival.

The Vikings won every bout from 160 to heavyweight to turn what was once a 15-point deficit into a 45-27 win at Monte Close Gymnasium.

The win for the Vikings was their 15th of the season, which is the most dual meets Glendale has won in one season in its history. Their previous best was a 14-4 campaign in 2001-02. It also solidified Glendale's seeding for district duals, as the Vikings are currently sixth with just one more match to go before pairings are finalized.

"I'm very pleased," Glendale head coach Bill Damiano said. "Any time you win this backyard rivalry, it's a good thing. It was a good match that didn't get decided until close to the end. These seniors will remember this match their whole life ... beating Mo Valley at Mo Valley. And setting the new record for dual meet wins is something to be proud of, too."

Mo Valley led the dual meet 27-18 after Black Knight Caleb Dugan's pin of Josh Yaworski at 152 before the Vikings ran off five straight wins — four by fall — to grab the victory.

But it may have been two cru-

cial wins in the middleweights that keyed the Glendale win.

With his team behind, 21-9, Viking Codi McClellan, who was wrestling up a weight at 140, scored a fall over Marc Godin in the night's wildest match.

Godin got the initial takedown, but McClellan matched the two-pointer, using a switch to get the reverse. Godin escaped near the end of the period to take a 3-2 lead.

McClellan began the second period on the bottom and almost got caught in a cradle by Godin. But the Black Knight's hands slipped and he lost control of the hold. McClellan was able to use that to get another reverse and

take a 4-3 lead. But Godin hit a switch moments later and reversed McClellan for a 5-4 advantage.

Godin then put in a half nelson and was turning McClellan to his back when the Viking flipped Godin to his back and notched three nearfall points to regain the lead and get some breathing room at 9-5.

The wrestlers traded reverses again in the third period, but McClellan was able to turn his into a pinning combination, catching Godin at 5:39 for a big Glendale win.

"What a big win there," Damiano said. "Godin had pinned him in the Tri-County Tournament, so he was hoping he got moved up to wrestle him tonight."

"He (Godin) kind of looked for the same thing a couple times and it wasn't there," Mo Valley head coach J.R. Holenchik said.

"And when he did turn him on the half, he got flipped for two and three. That was the difference in the match. If that doesn't happen, he doesn't have to go for broke and hang overtop and then get pinned. He went from putting (McClellan) on his back to getting turned to his for two and three. Obviously, that was the turning point. They wrestled a good match."

Glendale's Steve Rusnak followed the McClellan fall with a 4-1 decision over Josh Bryan at 145 pounds, closing the gap in the dual meet to 21-18.

"Rusnak was huge," Damiano said. "That was a great situation for us. He needed to get that and get a little confidence under his belt. I was real happy with him."

Mo Valley briefly halted the Viking momentum with Dugan's 55-second fall over Yaworski, but had a precarious nine-point lead heading into the strength of Glendale's lineup, where it lost four of the next five by fall.

"Obviously, we didn't want to get pinned as much as we did. That killed us," Holenchik said. "We had to win in the middleweights at 140 and 145, but we didn't. So that's the difference. They won where we needed to, and they pinned us. We didn't put ourselves in a position to win."

Mike Hommer pinned Chris Davis with a headlock in 43 seconds to get the Vikes within three of the lead, 27-24.

Robert Jeffries notched a hard-fought, 5-2, decision over Shane Murarik at 171 to knot the dual meet at 27-27. Jeffries scored the initial takedown and eventually worked Murarik to his back, but the Knight senior

fought off the bottom to go into the second period down, 5-1.

A second-period Murarik escape finalized the scoring.

"You can't let quality kids off their back," Damiano said. "Murarik's tough on his feet. But boy, Jeffries is really coming into his own over the last few weeks. He's wrestled the toughest 171-pounders in the district."

Craig Bickford gave Glendale its first lead of the night, when he pinned Charles Smith in 1:16. Cody Caracciolo followed with a fall over Caleb Selvage in 1:22, and Dave Brown finished off the meet by pinning Black Knight Chris Waite in 2:00.

The dual meet started at 103 where Glendale chose to forfeit to Mo Valley's Nathan Smeal and bump Justin O'Shell up to 112 to face Nathan Jacoby.

Jacoby topped O'Shell 5-1 to give Mo Valley a 9-0 lead, but Damiano was happy with the result of that bout and felt his team was positioned well for the remainder of the meet.

"There were some key moves by both teams, but the kids made us look good," Damiano said. "It wasn't that we wanted to forfeit

at 103, we wanted to anchor (Mo Valley). I thought there would be no match at 112 and they would bump up through the lineup. That's why we made that move."

Joel Walstrom upped the Black Knight lead to 15-0 with a 45-second pin of Ken Traveny, before Viking Bryant Sweitzer put his team on the scoreboard by flattening Max Holden in 1:44.

The Black Knights moved ahead, 21-6, at 130 where Kurtis Jacoby pinned Nathan Glass in 5:02. Jacoby led 4-0 after one period and 12-0 after two. In the third, he started on top, threw in the half and turned Glass to his back for the fall.

Glendale's Jordan Marshall defeated Ryan Viard by decision, 7-2, at 135 to make the score of the dual meet, 21-9.

"Viard wrestled a pretty good match up to the third period when I think he just couldn't come off the bottom anymore," Holenchik said. "There was a lot of riding on top, I thought, but that doesn't matter because (Ryan) had to come up and get hand control, and he didn't. But he wrestled pretty well up to that point."

That set up the big Viking wins at 140 and 145. Glendale which is now 15-6 overall, has won seven dual meets in a row.

"We're 7-0. We started a new season after losing to Chestnut Ridge the other night," Damiano said. "We're 7-0 since then, and we're hoping to run the table."

The Black Knights dropped to 5-5

"We obviously wanted to come out of here 6-4, but we're not wrestling too bad," Holenchik said. "We wrestled a team that has 15 wins, so I'm not hanging my head. I wish we could win them all, and I know the kids want to. But we just didn't put ourselves in a position to win tonight."

Both teams are back in action Thursday.

Glendale hosts Portage, while Mo Valley travels to Penns Valley.

Bickford trailed 1-0 in the first


